1. DUPLITZER, is WOLFF's assistant. His father was Yugoslav, his mother a Pole. Born in Istanbul. His father was a messenger in the old Austrian Embassy.
2. Duplitzer is called the Sherlock Holmes of the Gestapo and works at everything pertaining to espionage.
3. Regarded previously as the best spy for little things in Turkey and his fluency in Turkish is a great advantage to him. He is the payoff man for the Turkish Police.
4. He has amassed a large sum of money because he always takes a cut on any of the money he handles, "like any good Levantine" according to source. His chief lieutenant is FARRUH INCE.
5. Source regards Duplitzer as an excellent contact man for the Gestapo because he knows every policeman "who is worth knowing." He is an ardent Nazi and plans to return to Germany.
