Son quarrels developed between DURCANSKY, the Slovak Foreign Minister and Bernhard, the German Ambassador and a fanatical Nazi. DURCANSKY said that Slovakia was new out of the war, since they were only fighting Poland, so asked various foreign powers, including the Allies to send Ambassadors to the Slovak Government. DURCANSKY was also very much opposed to the Nazification of Slovaks. F. (meaning Fiala) was asked for a report on DURCANSKY's policy. He wrote that the two men would never agree because one was a Slovak Minister, whereas the other was the envoy of the Nazi Party and not even of the State/. Page 11. Meeting With Ribbentrop. 70. Early 1940, Fiala was called to Salzburg together with Bernhard, DURCANSKY, Tisso, Tuka and many other ministers. Ribbentrop saw F., thanked him for his report, and said that he was quite right- Bernhard must be removed, but from grounds of prestige, DURCANSKY must also go.</p> <p>THAT IS ALL THE PERTINENT INFO ON SUBJECT IN THE DOCUMENT.
