Most of the conversation was taken up by Mach's long defence of the reasons for which Slovakia had willy nilly to attach herself to the German war chariot. .... He (Novomesky) tells me (Capt F. Bassett) that he has seen Mach as recently as June of this year, has found the man more depressed than ever and more than ever going over the gamut of excuses for the policy which Slovakia adopted since Mach's Salzburg meeting in 1941.
