Dependable sources report that political refugees whose names are frequently found in the rosters of war criminals of the countries of the so-called Soviet block, have united in an international organization which is spreading its network in all capitals of Europe with the principal seat in Rome.</p> <p>.....</p> <p>"Your correspondent had an interview with Ferdinand DURCANSKY, "Foreign Minister" of the so-called Slovak Republic which as an ally of Hitler-Germany declared war against Russia, Poland, Great Britain and the United States. "Durcansky lives in Rome without any passport but he has frequently travelled into France. He declared that his aim is to make "the world finish the job which had been started and to declare war upon Soviet Russia without delay."
