1. Subject, who was former Prime Minister of Slovakia, departed Buenos Aires 12 September 1950 bearing a "No Argentino" passport issued under the name of Ferdinand DURČANSKY. Subject travelled through France, Belgium, Luxembourg, Austria and England and reportedly made contact with Slovak emigres in those countries.

2. Subject is the leader of a group known as the Council for Slovakian Liberation. This group is in opposition to the National Slovakian Council in Exile which is headed by Dr. Karol SIDOR, ex-Ambassador of Czechoslovakia to the Vatican.

3. According to Source, Subject is presently in England and plans to travel to Canada from where he will attempt to enter the United States.

4. Source has reported that Subject intends to meet with Dr. SIDOR, possibly in Canada, with the object of clarifying relations between the two Slovakian emigre groups.
