4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

The following information was obtained on 9 February 1952 from Confidential Informant 5010-T, who in turn obtained this information from one of his sub-sources. Evaluation: Source "B" (usually reliable); Sub-Source "C" (fairly reliable); Information "3" (possibly true).

Attached to the original of this report only as Exhibit I is the first issue of the periodical "WIR FURCHTLOSEN" (We Fearless People), published by the Friedrich Nietzsche Publishing House in Munich, Owner and Editor in Chief, Alois Eder, Linz, printed in Wels, Upper Austria by "Welsormuehl". This booklet contains numerous Anti - Western and Pro - Nazi articles.

Eder was born on 17 February 1919 in St. Florian, District Linz - Land, Upper Austria, Austrian National, no religious preference, married, residing in Linz, Negrelliweg 21. As associate editor one Mirko Jelusich has been registered. Eder allegedly is planning to take a trip to Germany early in 1952 to make an on the spot investigation concerning the status of the future German Army and to check on the conditions under which men are being recruited. He is allegedly planning to emigrate to Germany, provided he will have a financial advantage, and also plans to apply for service in the German Army.

Additional information received from Source indicated that the person responsible for the contents of this publication is one (fnu) Lehner, a student from Vienna who is probably identical with Gerhard Lehner, St. Pantzras an der Fyrrnbahn No. 22, Upper Austria. A friend of Lehner is Dr. Folke Rinner, who is on good terms with Stephan Schachermayer. Eder also has been seen many times recently in the company of Schachermayer.

FILE CHECK:

Files of this Sub-Detachment contain the following information concerning ~~former VDU Functionary~~ Former VDU Functionary in Upper Austria, made Anti - US speeches in Soviet Zone of Austria, former SS Obersturmbannfuhrer. Eder is one of the original leaders of the SAoe - Revolutionary Socialist Workers Organization, he is one of the early organizers of the Nationale Liga, in Upper Austria. Alois Eder is also listed as a possible KPOe member in AR Case No. L/23586, Subject "KPOe Members in the City of Linz", dated 17 September 1951.

Files of this Sub-Detachment contain the following information concerning Mirko Jelusich: He is listed as one of the Austrian authors who signed a Petition for the Release of General von Rendulic. Numerous reports concerning Stefan Schachermayer, former NS Gauinspector, are on file with this office.
