Made several statements ~~XXXXXX~~ obviously not correct, which EGGEN must have know were not true. (interrog. re Germany, in general). This eval. states that EGGEN, like other German emissaries, trying to split Allies by maintaining Russians already negotiating with Germany and "not playing fair with us." Writer believes it most dangerous even ~~toxam~~ make it appear as though Allies willing to believe such statement and perhaps establ. contact with high German official on basis thereof.
