 - In the letter SKORZENY states that SERVATIUS has asked him to recommend a lawyer in Argentina who will take up the EICHMANN cause. SKORZENY is trying to enlist the help of JACOVELLA and suggests that JACOVELLA come to Madrid for further discussions.
 - Traces are requested on JACOVELLA and RAMOS, U. S. files only. [Munich] files contain no traces.
 - [redacted] Reference reported that Vera EICHMANN was trying to arrange her husband's deportation to Argentina and was dealing with Dr. Fou GRADIN, a lawyer in Buenos Aires. FYI: RECHENBERG is an UPHILL case officer who has regular contact with Dr. SERVATIUS and the EICHMANN family.
