

MEMORANDUM FOR: Mr. Dulles

From all that I can find, the German Government under the contractuals has jurisdiction over all ^{war} criminals including the trying of them and Germany seems to be the only one that does have this jurisdiction. If our people should find Eichmann, the only legal course open would be to inform the German Government who could then extradite him for trial. If the government of the country in which he is found was one the Agency has some influence in, we might be able to use our good offices to assist in the extradition. Over and beyond that, any action taken by the Agency would have to be of a covert and illegal nature.
