1. HEID ASKED ON 8 SEPTEMBER TO SEE WHAT COULD BE DONE TO REMOVE ENGELSINGS FROM CTB BLACKLIST. ON 8 NOVEMBER HEID ADVISED US THAT EUCOM REGARDS IT AS BEYOND THEIR SCOPE TO QUERY THE BRITISH FOR REASON OF PLACING INDIVIDUALS ON LIST OR TO INTERCEDE FOR TAKING THEM OFF.

2. TO GET ACTION, WE HAVE TO TELL MORE AND MAKE STRONGER CASE WITH EUCOM. SUGGEST BERN SUPPLY WRITTEN STATEMENT FOR EUCOM TO PASS TO BRITISH.
