Engineer. Refugee in Sweden since 1944. Graduated from the 2nd Municipal Gymnasium in Riga in ab.1936; studied engineering at the University of Latvia and graduated from it. Member of the Fraternity "Latvija". In Sweden known as an active member of the Latvian right wing. Is a close friend of GINTERS Hugo (see card 4750) - both did some blackmarketing in West Germany, Hamburg area, in 1946/47, as the representatives of the Latvian EMOA in Sweden. Knows very well VALDEMARS. Now candidate of the National Workers' (List No.1) on the elections of the Latvian representative body in Sweden in Oct.1955 (see also card 4755). In ab.1950 got married to KURMIS Guna, daughter of teacher and politician Ansis K.; she studied music in Latvia and became a well known pianist in Sweden. (C).

Guna KURMIS, graduate of a gymnasium, attended 1938-44 the Latvian Conservatory, piano class; 1942-44 soloist-pianist at the Riga Radio; has had several concerts while in exile in Sweden; in 1951 obtained the rights to be a soloist at the concerts of the Konserterforeningen together with orchestra.
