In order to help keep track of @FRIESEN and his activities during his stay in Berlin from 2-5 August 1960, CALLIKAK mail coverage on @FRIESEN's "Erbonkel" and a tape-recorded tap on @FRIESEN's Berlin Compound telephone were initiated. (The telephone tap was accomplished without the involvement of any German personnel.) @FRIESEN turned down [ ] invitations to "a few drinks and dinner" on 2 and 3 August, making even partial monitoring of @FRIESEN's evening activities impossible. @FRIESEN departed from Tempelhof for Munich about 1900 on 5 August.

2. The CALLIKAK mail coverage on @FRIESEN's "Erbonkel" will be continued until about 1 September. The results to date are attached (Att. 1). Other intercepts will be dispatched soonest after 1 September. The telephone tap will be continued indefinitely (at least through the tour of @MANDNER in the Berlin Compound, which tour will take place late in August and early September). The tape of the telephone tap during @FRIESEN's stay in the Compound is attached (Att. 4); comments on this tape are given below (para. 4).

3. @FRIESEN was in possession of a Berlin Compound pass, a photocopy of which is attached (Att. 3). The pass, which is valid to 31 December 1960, was returned to BOB via @BORG on 9 August and can be used by @FRIESEN in the future in lieu of the daily temporary pass which BOB has issued to UPHILL/AENIDUS visitors in the past. It was first assumed that passport photos would be required by the Army before the issuance of the attached passes. @FRIESEN and @MANDNER, therefore, sent such photos in advance of @FRIESEN's arrival. Copies of these photos and negatives are attached (Att. 1).

4. The attached tape has been recorded at 3 3/4 rpm. The following comments may be of assistance in a content analysis of the tape:

2 August

a. @FRIESEN dialed 94 66 55 and his call was answered by "MEISSNER". This call was to someone concerned with the Dieter JAHNKE recruitment case, probably to @REIMANN (@KAUFMANN was scheduled to make the contact with JAHNKE's sister). The telephone number is subscribed to by Otto MEISSNER of Berlin-Charlottenburg, Ebereschen Allee 58. The name is probably a cover for the Hamburg Aussenstelle of UPHILL's Bremen Dienststelle. @FRIESEN passed on to [ ] the essential elements in this phone call.

c. This call was made by @FRIESEN to 91 03 21, the number of the Hotel Roxy, Berlin-W 15, Kurfuerstendamm 34, in an effort to reach one Hans KUNZ (see paras. f, g, h, j, l, and m, below). [ ]

f. Another call to Hotel Roxy, 91 03 21.

g. @FRIESEN, evidently disturbed by his failure to reach Herr KUNZ, tried 37 76 19. The phone was answered by "REHFELD". The number 37 76 19 is unlisted. Without the help of one or more German nationals in the CALLIKAK program, it would be impossible to trace this number; BOB, therefore, has not asked for CALLIKAK traces.

h. @FRIESEN finally reached Hans KUNZ, who, by his accent, is a Sachsen. It is interesting to note that @FRIESEN and KUNZ are on "du" terms and that @FRIESEN, himself a Sachsen, tends to lapse into a Sachsen accent toward the end of the conversation. There is some indication, based on the conversation, that KUNZ is involved in courier activity (see also paras. j, l, and m, below).

4 August

1. [ ] @FRIESEN

j. @FRIESEN received this call from Hans KUNZ. It is interesting that KUNZ called (Hans) @FRIESEN "Heinz".

k. During a call from @FRIESEN to Dr. VOGEL (UPHILL Hqs.), the names "SOLWING" and "WAHRGOWITZ" are mentioned.

l. @FRIESEN/KUNZ

m. @FRIESEN/KUNZ

5. Att. (5) are memos of conversations with @FRIESEN. Para. 5 of the 2 August memo is of particular interest. The subject of this paragraph, Karl-Heinz WICHODIL, has since been traced by the LfV/Berlin and by OSI/Berlin. @FRIESEN said that traces on WICHODIL had been requested through MOB/LD just prior to his departure from Munich. BOB has no record of WICHODIL in its files and @FRIESEN was so informed.
