1. IN THE PAST WEEK, THE FOLLOWING PERPLEXING POINTS INVOLVING THE CASE CAME UP IN DISCUSSIONS WITH ALIAS BERNHARDT AND ALIAS STURM--

A. FRL. KUNZE'S WRITEUP OF THE HQS DISCUSSIONS, A COPY OF WHICH WE RECEIVED LOCALLY, INDICATED THAT HAD STATED THAT ALIAS GREGOR /TRUE NAME USED/ WAS A POLISH AGENT. HER NOTES WENT ON TO SAY THAT STUCK BY THIS CLAIM UNTIL REQUERIED ON 25 OR 26 APRIL. HE THEN CHANGED HIS POSITION AND CLAIMED THAT HE WAS SURE ONLY THAT CIRCA 57/58 OR 58/59 ALIAS GREGOR WAS "IN BEARBEITUNG" AND DID NOT KNOW IF HE HAD ACTUALLY BEEN RECRUITED. WE ASKED BERNHARDT ABOUT THIS ON 25 MAY. HE SAID HE BELIEVED HAD NOT NAMED GREGOR AS A POLISH AGENT UNTIL AFTER DEFECTED, BUT HE WAS NOT SURE JUST WHEN THIS INFO HAD COME OUT. HE ADDED THAT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE QUERIED AGAIN CONCERNING HIS KNOWLEDGE OF GREGOR AND ALSO WOULD BE SHOWN A PHOTO OF GREGOR WHICH BERNHARDT PROMISED TO GIVE US SOON FOR SENDING TO HQS.

B. ON 24 MAY RAISED THE GENERAL SUBJECT OF GRAPHOLOGY WITH ALIAS STURM IN THE COURSE OF A ROUTINE MEETING. THEN ASKED IF UPHILL HAD DONE A GRAPHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT OF UJDROWSY. STURM SAID HE WAS NOT SURE AND ADDED THAT EVEN IF UPHILL HAD, THE RESULT WOULD NOT BE NEARLY AS DETAILED OR GOOD AS THE EXCELLENT ASSESSMENT KUBARK HAD DONE. STURM SAID HE WAS HIGHLY IMPRESSED WITH KUBARK'S CAPABILITY IN THIS FIELD AND EXPRESSED SOME SURPRISE THAT WE INDULGED IN THIS SORT OF THING. ATTEMPTED TO DRAW STURM OUT TO SEE JUST WHICH KUBARK ASSESSMENT HE WAS TALKING ABOUT. STURM QUOTED IN DETAIL THE LAST PARAGRAPH OF THE UJDROWSY GRAPHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT FORWARDED WITH EGMW-10565.

2. OUR COMMENTS ON THE ABOVE ARE AS FOLLOWS--

A. WE WOULD LIKE TO KNOW JUST WHEN FIRST MENTIONED ALIAS GREGOR'S TRUE NAME AND DESCRIBED HIM AS A POLISH AGENT. THERE IS NO RECORD IN OUR FILES THAT THIS EVER HAPPENED, EXCEPT THE RECENT INFO FROM UPHILL. THERE ALSO IS NO MENTION OF THIS HIGHLY SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT IN THE REFERENCE DISPATCH REPORTING THE KUBARK DISCUSSIONS WITH BERNHARDT IN WASHINGTON.

B. WE WOULD LIKE TO KNOW IF BERNHARDT WAS GIVEN A COPY OF THE KUBARK GRAPHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT ON UJDROWSY OR IF THE ASSESSMENT MERELY WAS DISCUSSED WITH HIM. THIS TOPIC IS NOT MENTIONED IN THE REFERENCE. FEELS THAT STURM'S KNOWLEDGE OF THE ASSESSMENT IS SO DETAILED THAT HE MUST HAVE SEEN A COPY OF IT. BERNHARDT HAS NOT MENTIONED THE SUBJECT, NOR IS IT MENTIONED IN FRL. KUNZE'S NOTES ON THE DISCUSSIONS IN HQS. NEEDLESS TO SAY, WE HAVE NOT PASSED A COPY TO UPHILL, NOR HAVE WE MENTIONED THAT SUCH AN ASSESSMENT EXISTS.

3. HQS COMMENTS ON THE ABOVE WOULD BE APPRECIATED.
