1. The following information supplements that forwarded in reference on UJDROWSY's relatives in the United States:

- a. Paul R. NEUHAUSSER was born 4 March 1889 in Augustusburg, Germany. He left Germany on the SS HUDSON, which left from Bremen, on 22 December 1921 and arrived in the U.S. on 5 January 1922. He filed a declaration of intention to become an American citizen on 17 January 1923, at which time he listed his residence as 2418 Iowa Street, Cincinnati, Ohio. His last German residence was New Ruppin, Germany.
- b. Mrs. Marie Magdalene NEUHAUSSER was born on 11 July 1888 in Augustusburg, Germany. Her son, Henry NEUHAUSSER, was born in Cincinnati on 10 May 1924.
- c. Paul R. NEUHAUSSER was naturalized on 27 June 1927 (Naturalization Certificate No. 2,593,806). His physical description was as follows: 5 feet four inches tall, medium complexion, grey eyes, black hair. His residence at that time was 2331 Bishop Street, Cincinnati.
