6. ARRANGEMENTS FOR RELEASE OF MENDE AND GROSSE HAD BEEN STALLED BY BUREAUCRATIC HASSLE BETWEEN ALL GERMAN AFFAIRS MINISTRY, JUSTICE MINISTRY AND CAWHISPER.
