[Text] As Heinz Felte, Moscow's longtime master spy for the West German Federal Press Service (BND), himself predicted in February following his release from ~~the~~ Straubingen 's cell No. 477, the dogs of the Soviet press service are at his throat again. The "dormant volcano" Felte who has been reactivated against the will of the BND and exchanged for three German students imprisoned in the USSR, gave the KGB's Misinformation Section an initial assist in the newspaper campaign against the BND and the Federal Office for the Protection of the Constitution (BfV). For a series of articles in the government newspaper IZVESTIYA the KGB had Felte point out the BND branch office ^{with its} Uran ~~component~~ ^{and} Neutron which ~~is~~ according to IZVESTIYA is supposed to have begun the "operations and provocations" against the Soviet diplomats in the Federal Republic. In the case of Yuri Vorontsov, the KGB agent who resided in Bonn, ^{and} whose blood contained alcohol when he rammed into another automobile and subsequently died, the KGB had IZVESTIYA voice the ^csuspicion of attempted murder: "Which of these affiliates participated in the automobile accident..." Neither because "Uran" and "Neutron" which had once really been the contact offices for the BND with the BfV to coordinate counterespionage were closed in 1961 -- after Felte's arrest.
