According to a report dated 1 April 1963, Subject was at one time of interest to an unidentified American Intelligence agency, and may possibly have been compromised to the Russian Intelligence Service by Helmut FELFE, who could have had access to information passed in a written memorandum by the Central Intelligence Agency to the West German Intelligence Service.


