

3. Results of a credit check on Subject have been received from CACROZE. There are no startling revelations in the report - Subject has apparently established himself as a solid small-businessman - and it has therefore been attached in untranslated form. Apart from that, we have been monitoring the mail received at Subject's home and business addresses (excluding the now-defunct Bayerstr. address, which proved to be unmanageable because of the large number of firms at the address). So far, the mail read has been innocent in the extreme.
4. Although CASTONE/4 was initially encouraged to cultivate Subject, it has been decided that he ~~should not accompany Subject to Switzerland~~. To get anything out of it, CASTONE/4 would almost certainly need to expose himself, which would be inadvisable in any case but particularly so in Subject's case, since his dealings with Rumanian officials do not seem to have advanced very far. We will keep Subject under sporadic observation, with the thought that a recruitment scheme can be devised if a development occurs that makes it attractive.
