ACTION REQUIRED: Project Renewal -- Reprocess Contracts

1. The contracts of CASTONE-4, [ ] [ ] are herewith returned for reprocessing.

2. KUFUNE has indicated that these contracts cannot be processed for the following reasons:

a. KUFUNE feels (and Division agrees) that a DMW 50 per month raise every six months for an indefinite period is excessive. These raises added to the already substantial salaries are too high to be covered by Project CASTONE as presently written. We take full note of MEMA 23917, 7 November 1956, outlining the GIBEX pay scale and in the name of career and local custom will agree to its provisions. However, we should like to point out that your contracts go far beyond the provisions of the GIBEX policy as your contracts provide for six month increases in salary for the length of the contract.

b. Your contracts contain provisions for the equivalent of one years compensation in case of death. This we cannot accept as there is no provision for such payments in the CASTONE project outline.

3. Should you feel strongly that the payments mentioned in Paragraph 2b above should be made, it is recommended either that a project amendment be submitted justifying these costs or that the matter be held in abeyance until a project renewal is submitted by MEM providing for the additional benefits. In connection with this renewal you are reminded that CASTONE expires on 31 July and a project renewal would be appreciated as soon as possible.

4. We recommend that in the future contracts be submitted using operational pseudonyms instead of true names. If these individuals do not presently have such pseudonyms it is suggested that they be provided with them. This will save us the trouble of sanitizing the contracts and writing certificates in

order to legalize them.

5. We note also that both contracts and memos of oral agreements have been submitted on the Subject individuals. This is not necessary. In actuality we see no legal reason for contracts at all. However if you believe that the existence of a contract is any real assistance in your handling of these agents we are quite willing to go along with it. As far as fulfilling the Headquarters requirements, either one will do.
