- Forwarded herewith for your information is a copy of a report by CASTONE-4 on one Ing. ^{Franz} (fnu) HAINDL, born ca. 1928 in Vienna. *copy rest from att.*
- The information was given to CASTONE-4 by Max RIEDL, described in the report, on the basis of RIEDL's opinion that CASTONE-4 is involved in police work. RIEDL and CASTONE-4 are personal friends of about 9 years standing; the acquaintance is also supported by the friendship between RIEDL's wife, a doctor, and CASTONE-4's wife, a Viennese. To the information on RIEDL given in the report, CASTONE-4 also stated upon questioning that RIEDL was in the "Panzer" during the second World War and spent time in a Russian PW Camp.
- Munich files contain no traces on HAINDL or RIEDL.
