1. ABE, Hans HJ Leader HAMBURG, Rotenbaumchaussee 113. FLEGEL and DE CHELARD met ABE by chance at HERDE's flat on 18 Jun 46. (See also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 1 and Appendix B to DIC FR 112, No 1)
2. ALTHOFF Circus FLEGEL endeavoured to get in touch with this circus, as he had heard from RENKEN that one of RENKEN's friends (BARTSCH?) could find him employment there.
3. BANGERT, fmu W/SS Introduced to FLEGEL by EWERT on 1 Aug 46. He told FLEGEL that he had been employed by the LÜBECK police, and had been dismissed owing to his former SS membership. He obtained a false D2 form by persuading a discharged soldier to report to a release camp and to be discharged a second time. FLEGEL asked BANGERT whether he could obtain an SS typewriter. He replied that there were still a number of former W/SS men with the police in LÜBECK who could help in this connection. BANGERT hoped to obtain employment with the Railway Police in HAMBURG.
4. BARTLING, fmu SS Ostbaf GÜTERSLOH. Former Ia of SS Div HJ. Contact of REHMEN and POGGENGERD. Left GÜTERSLOH for US Zone, but was expected back again about mid Jul 46. FLEGEL endeavoured in vain to get in touch with him.
5. BARTSCH, (?) fmu Former regimental comrade of RENKEN. Employed in Circus ALTHOFF. RENKEN advised FLEGEL to get in touch with BARTSCH with a view to obtaining work.
6. BERNOTAT, Fritz HJ Leader H/DEMLRSCHEN. Friend of DE CHELARD. Employed at Labour Exchange in REMDSBURG. FLEGEL visited him on 15 Jun 46 regarding employment, and again on 19 Jun 46. He offered FLEGEL one or two jobs as an insurance agent with firms in REMDSBURG and HAMBURG.
7. BRASSCHAT, fmu See ECHOULD.
8. BREHER, Clemens (Ex-Prisoner DIC.) Formerly lived at IPEKHOE. Friend of GALLA since 1933/34. Harboured ECHOULD for one or two nights in Jun 45. Known to DE CHELARD, who visited him frequently. (See also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 10.)

9. BROKER, Joehen SS Ustuf LÜBECK.
Formerly in LSSAH. WEBER succeeded in getting him into the LÜBECK police. FLEGEL was introduced to him on 2 Aug 46 at WEBER's flat. He told FLEGEL to call on his friend SIEGEL in BREMEN, whom he considered a likely source for D2 forms. On 5 Sep 46 he suggested to FLEGEL that he should hold a meeting of former SS members at LÜBECK and establish a centre where they could congregate. ZELLER informed him and FLEGEL on 6 Sep 46 that he (ZELLER) had been ordered to report to the PSO LÜBECK on 7 Sep 46. BROKER informed FLEGEL on 16 Sep 46 that ZELLER had been arrested.
10. BUCHOLZ, Arnold See SCHRÖDER, Arnold.
11. BULL, Wilhelm ELISHORN. Acquaintance of FLEGEL. FLEGEL called on him on 11 Jun 46 to borrow money, but refrained from asking him as he was received coldly. (See also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111 No 8).
12. CASPARI See CASPARI.
13. CLAUSSEN or Farmer
CLASSEN, frn NORDHASTEDT. FLEGEL stayed at his farm on 8 and 9 Jul 46. (See also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 14).
14. CZICH, Willi Obannf HJ VENNE. Was introduced to DE CHELARD at SCHRÖDER's flat at VENNE beg Jan 46. LAPINS and MICHEL were present at the time. DE CHELARD tried unsuccessfully to persuade them to join "his group".
15. DE CHELARD HJ Leader
© SCHELLER, Arno MÜNSTERDORF. Beg Jan 46 met SCHRÖDER, NICKEL, LAPINS and CZICH at SCHRÖDER's flat at VENNE and told them that he was in touch with HOLMEN and other individuals at ITZEHOE who hoped for a revival of some form of National Socialism. He tried unsuccessfully to persuade all those present to join "his group". End Mar - beg Apr 46 visited VENNE again and tried to persuade MICHEL, LAPINS and CZICH to join GALLA's "Anti-Bewegung", again without success. May '46 LAPINS visited DE CHELARD and told him not to involve their names in the "Anti-Bewegung" or any other org. FLEGEL and SPRINGER called on DE CHELARD on 5 Jun 46. He told them about GALLA's "A-Orden" ("Anti-Bewegung"), of which GALLA was said to be the second-in-command. He gave SPRINGER one blank D2 form. FLEGEL and SPRINGER called on him again on 9 Jun 46. FLEGEL asked him whether Dr GRUNE could remove his blood group tattoo. He made the necessary arrangements and Dr GRUNE operated on FLEGEL the same evening.

DE CHELARD visited HILLERS on 14 Jun 46 and expounded his political intentions. FERDE and FLEGEL were also present. FLEGEL saw DE CHELARD on 17 Jun 46 and informed him of his meeting with EDEL, LUMITSCH and SCHOLZ. FLEGEL travelled with him to FLEBURG on 18 Jun 46 and called on KOHNKE. Later they went to HELDE's flat and met ABE by chance. This was the last time DE CHELARD and FLEGEL were together. (See also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 11 and Appendix B to DIC FR 112, No 5).

16. DEGNER, Joachim

See DORAU, Joachim.

17. DILL, Frau

ITZEHOE, Reichenstr 23. GALLA's former landlord. Harboured ECHOULD(?) for one or two nights in Jun 45, prior to his escape to BELGIUM. Provided RM 2000 bail for HOMMEN.

18. DITTERN, Oskar

See DOBAT, Oskar.

19. DOBAT, Oskar Hptbannf HJ
@ DITTERN, Oskar

Contact of DE CHELARD and known to LAPINS NICKEL, SCHROEDER and DORAU. Parted company with the a/n at GLÜCKSBURG on 8 May 45.

20. DORAU, Joachim Obannf HJ
@ DEGNER, Joachim

Contact of DE CHELARD and known to SCHROEDER, LAPINS and NICKEL. Wife and children live on Island of AMRUM. Was in VEINE in Jan 46.

21. ECHOULD(?) Frau
@ BRASSCHAT Frau

Belgian SS man. Escaped from Westerhof Wehrmacht hospital at ITZEHOE in Jun 45. GALLA assisted him by finding him accommodation at DILL's and BREHER's homes. HOMMEN provided him with false papers.

22. EDEL, Frau SS Leader

Acquaintance of Frau WOLTER, Former Ic under SS Ogruf von GOTTBURG. FLEGEL was introduced to him by Frau WOLTER on 15 Jun 46. FLEGEL informed him of DE CHELARD's political intentions. EDEL told FLEGEL that he was willing to shelter any of DE CHELARD's people and that he could procure identity papers. Declared his willingness to participate in any anti-Communist org, provided that such an org did not run counter to the policy of the Western Powers. FLEGEL saw him on 6 Jul 46 at ALBERSDORF and informed him of DE CHELARD's arrest. Supplied HOMMEN with an identity card.

23. EWERT, Walter W/SS

C/o LANGE, Kunstühle, MALENTE. Formerly in charge of a W/SS Nachrichtenschule in the SUDETENLAND (?). Acquaintance of HILDE SCHAFER. FLEGEL called on him on 1 Aug 46. He introduced BANGERT to FLEGEL. FLEGEL asked EWERT whether he could get him an SS typewriter. EWERT referred him to WEBER.

24. FABIG, fru
GÜTERSLOH. Confectioner. POGGENGERD's employer.
25. GALLA, Erika, Witwe
Frau
See MATHIAS, Erika.
26. GASPARI, fru
(or CASPARI (?))
Said to have received couriers from Russian Zone at the house of Dr LÜCKEN in BRELEN (see also Dr LÜCKEN).
27. GRUNE, Dr med, fru
MÜNSTERDORF. Friend of DE CHELARD. Removed FLEGEL's tattoo marks on 9 Jun 46. FLEGEL called on him on 5 Jul 46, and informed him of DE CHELARD's arrest. (See also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 28.)
28. GÜNTHER
See WEBER.
29. HAHN, fru SS Ustuf
LÜBECK. Enlisted in police force at LÜBECK through WEBER. FLEGEL met HAHN on 2 Aug 46 at WEBER's flat. FLEGEL met him again on 29 Aug 46 at the police stn in LÜBECK. HAHN called on FLEGEL at WEBER's flat and informed him of ZELLER's arrest.
30. HAUER, Eugen SS Leader
o/o former HENRICHS, HANSSSEL. Acquaintance of Frau TEGELER, Hilde SCHAFER and Atti LANGE. FLEGEL saw him on 20 Jun 46 and spoke to him of DE CHELARD and his intentions.
31. HEIN, Gerd Obstlt
NIEBÜLL. FLEGEL visited HEIN and his fiancée (Fräulein Petri MATTHIESEN) on 7 Jun 46 to enquire whether he had any news of Frau SPRINGER. FLEGEL also informed him of DE CHELARD's intentions and suggested that he should meet DE CHELARD. HEIN informed FLEGEL that he intended to visit his friend Max HILLERS at ITZEHOE on 15 Jun 46 and arranged with FLEGEL to meet him and DE CHELARD there (NB: HEIN was prevented by his arrest on 8 Jun 46 from keeping this appointment.) HEIN wrote DE CHELARD from EULENSBURG prison that SPRINGER's wife was there and that he had been questioned about FLEGEL, SPRINGER and DE CHELARD (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 32).
32. HINCHES, Ben Farmer
HILTBEL. Employed by HILTBEL and visited FLEGEL in Jul 46.
33. HERDE, Karl Bannf HJ
HÄMBURG, Rotenbaumchaussee 113. FLEGEL and SPRINGER called on HERDE on 4 Jun 46 and were told that WÖHNKE was unable to supply D2 forms. FLEGEL and SPRINGER called on him again on 11 Jun 46, when SPRINGER received a loan of RM 200. On 13 Jun 46 FLEGEL told HERDE that he had arranged to meet HEIN on 15 Jun 46 at HILLERS' flat in ITZEHOE and that DE

CHELARD would also be present. HERDE agreed to go as well and FLEGEL gave him HILLERS' address. HEIN met FLEGEL and DE CHELARD at HILLERS' flat. FLEGEL and DE CHELARD met ABE by chance at HERDE's flat on 18 Jun 46 (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 31, and Appendix B FR 112, No 12).

34. HILLERS, Max NSKK

ITZEHOE, Wilholmastr 7. Friend of HEIN. FLEGEL called on him on 13 Jun 46 and introduced himself under the alias of "MIGSCH". HILLERS told FLEGEL that he was a former member of the NSKK and that the KPD had asked him to join their party. FLEGEL told him about DE CHELARD and asked him whether a meeting between FLEGEL, HEIN, DE CHELARD and HERDE could take place in his flat. HILLERS agreed, but pointed out that he had had news from HEIN's fiancée that HEIN would not be able to attend. (NB: HEIN was arrested on 8 Jun 46). FLEGEL, HERDE and DE CHELARD duly met at HILLERS' flat. FLEGEL called on him again on 5 Jul 46, and informed him of DE CHELARD's arrest. HILLERS told FLEGEL that DE CHELARD had visited him a few days previously and had shown him a letter from HEIN, from FLENSBURG gaol. The letter stated that the wife of SPRINGER was there as well, and that HEIN had been questioned concerning SPRINGER, DE CHELARD and FLEGEL. DE CHELARD expressed surprise at receiving this letter, since he did not know HEIN.

35. HORN, Fritz SS Ostufaf

NORDHASTEDT. Formerly FLEGEL's superior offr in the SS. Met FLEGEL in Feb 46.

36. JACOBS, fnu

KLÜVENHAGEN nr ETELSEN. Co-proprietor of coffee roasting firm in BREMEN and STEYERBERG. Friend of FLEGEL. Was member of Reitersturnbann BREMEN of the Allg SS from 1933 to 1937. Claims to have been expelled from the SS in 1937, but holds no official document from the SS to this effect. FLEGEL visited him on several occasions after mid Jun 46 and obtained for him from WEBER a false SS document certifying his expulsion from the SS. JACOBS gave FLEGEL a letter of introduction to REIKEN.

37. KALCHER, fnu Farmer

NORDHASTEDT. FLEGEL called on him on 8 Jun 46 to meet SPRINGER (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No. 35).

38. KICKBUSCH, Ernst
(or KLEKBUSCH)

ITZEHOE, Sandberg 112. Ritterkreuzträger and former tk comd. Contact of DE CHELARD and employee of HORNEN.

39. KÖHNKE, Helmut Photographor See Personall's Appendix to DIC FR 111 No 39 and DIC FR 112.
40. LANGE, Frau Kunststüble, MALENTE. Brother of Atti LANGE. EWERT was employed in his workshop.
41. LANGE, Adrienne (Atti) Friend of Hilde SCHÄFER. Sister of LANGE. Knows Frau TEGELER and has met MAUER.
42. LÜCKEN, Dr, Frau BREMEN, Schwachh^uuserheerstr. Former Oberbürgermeister of KIEL. In May 46, GALLA was told by a nurse employed by LÜCKEN that a General GASPARI regularly received couriers at LÜCKEN's house. These couriers were said to be former police offrs, who came at regular intervals from the Russian Zone with messages and detailed reports.
43. LUMITSCH, Frau SS Hptstuf VIERTHOF Estate nr ALBERSDORF. Contact of Frau WOLTER. Formerly in Pz Regt, SS TOTENKOPF Div. Introduced to FLEGEL by Frau WOLTER on 15 Jun 46. FLEGEL informed him of DE CHELLARD's political intentions. Declared his willingness to participate in any anti-Communist org provided such an org did not run counter to the policy of the Western Powers. He promised FLEGEL to find him a job on the VIERTHOF Estate. FLEGEL saw him there on 16 Jun 46 and on 6 Jul 46, and informed him of DE CHELLARD's arrest.
44. MATHIAK, Erika ITZEHOE, Klosterhof. GALLA's mistress. Prisoner made her acquaintance during the war in FÜRSTENWALDE. About beg Oct 45 Prisoner brought her from the Russian Zone to ITZEHOE, where she registered with the authorities in the name of Frau Erika GALLA, widow of Josef GALLA, a distant relative of GALLA. Has accompanied GALLA on several of his journeys.
@ Frau Witwe Erika GALLA
45. MATHIAK, Siegfried ITZEHOE, Klosterhof. Brother of Erika MATHIAK, ex-member of Wehrmacht released from Russian captivity and living with Erika MATHIAK.
46. MATTHIJSSEN, Frä Petri NIEBÜLL. Friend of HEIN. FLEGEL visited her at NIEBÜLL on 7 Jun 46 to enquire whether she had any news of Frau SPRINGER (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 46).
47. MORITZEN, Hans Obannf HJ NORDHASTEDT. (See Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 50).
48. OFFERMAN, Martinez ITZEHOE, OT Barracks, Lorenz Platz. Dutch national. GALLA made his acquaintance in May 45. Assisted in the escape of ESCOUUD. Contact of HOMER and BREMER. Former member of Dutch NS Party.

49. OMMEN, Dierk SS Man
LÜBECK, (?) Allee 81. FLEGEL met him on 2 Aug 46 at WEBER's flat. WEBER asked FLEGEL on 23 Aug 46 and again on 5 Sep 46 whether he could obtain a D2 form for OMMEN. FLEGEL called on OMMEN on 6 Sep 46. He was about to leave for HILBURG, with a view to obtaining employment in the building trade. He asked FLEGEL whether he could get him a D2 form. After his return from HILBURG the same day, he informed FLEGEL that he had found a job in HILBURG with a building firm and that he was to start work on 9 Sep 46. He also told FLEGEL that he intended calling on Frau WOLTER to obtain identity papers from EDEL for himself and a friend. He told FLEGEL on 16 Sep 46 that he had obtained an identity card from EDEL, which was, however, out of date.
50. POGGENGERD, fnu
C/o F.BIG, Confectioner, GÜTERSLOH. Contact of RENKEN and BARTLING. FLEGEL called on him on 2 Jul 46 and was told that BARTLING had left GÜTERSLOH for the US Zone and that he was not expected back until mid Jul 46. FLEGEL left a message with POGGENGERD that BARTLING should contact him through RENKEN.
51. POLZFUSS, Grete Nurse
BREMEN, Humboldtstr 26. Acquaintance of BRÖGER. Gave FLEGEL's address in BREMEN to FLEGEL.
52. RENKEN, fnu Insurance Broker
DELMENHORST, Brauenkampferstr 86. Contact of JACOBS. FLEGEL saw him on several occasions regarding employment. He advised FLEGEL to get in touch with BARKSCH (?) of Circus ALTHOFF with a view to obtaining work. He also informed FLEGEL that SS Ostufaf BARTLING was still at large and was living nr HERFORD, and that FLEGEL could contact him through POGGENGERD.
53. REUTER, Klaus HJ Leader
ITZEHOE (?) Friend of LAPINS. LAPINS visited him in ITZEHOE hospital beg Apr 46, and asked DE CHELARD to visit him. REUTER called on LAPINS at VENNE about Easter 46 and told him that DE CHELARD was persuaded her to join the EMB by making him believe that LAPINS had also become a member. In May 46 he told LAPINS that he did not wish to see DE CHELARD again.
54. SCHAFER, Hilde BDM Leader
HILBURG, Rotenbaunhaussce 91. FLEGEL and SPRINGER visited her on 5 Jun 46 to obtain news of SPENDER and DE CHELARD. She told FLEGEL that during the summer she would be working on a farm known to Frau TEGELER at ALTRIEDINGEN. FLEGEL saw her

at ALTEMEDINGEN on 20 Jun 46. She told him that a friend of Frau TEGELER, Eugen HAUER, was interested in DE CHELLARD, and suggested that FLEGEL should meet HAUER at HEIRICHS' farm at HALSSEL. FLEGEL saw SCHLEIFER again on 26 Jul 46. She said that she was going to HALBURG on 27 Jul 46, and he asked her to inform KOHNKE of DE CHELLARD's arrest. FLEGEL saw her on several occasions in HALBURG and ALTEMEDINGEN after that date. She gave him the name of EWERT as a likely source for an SS typewriter. On 30 Aug 46 FLEGEL told her about ZELLER. ZELLER called on FLEGEL at SCHLEIFER's flat on 31 Aug 46. FLEGEL saw SCHLEIFER for the last time on 4 Sep 46 (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 58, and Appendix B to DIC FR 112, No 23).

Former teleprinter operator in the police (?) Contact of Frau WOLTER. Introduced to FLEGEL by Frau WOLTER on 15 Jun 46. FLEGEL informed SCHOLZ of DE CHELLARD's intentions. He declared his willingness to participate in any anti-Communist org provided such an org did not run counter to the policy of the Western Powers.

VENNE. DE CHELLARD called on SCHROEDER at VENNE beg Jan 46 and also met CZICH, LAPINS and NICKEE there. DE CHELLARD tried to persuade them to join his "group". Was arrested under Operation "NURSERY", but released again May 46. Sent LAPINS to DE CHELLARD to tell him not to involve their names in the "Anti-Bewegung" or any other org.

BREMEN, Friedrich-Hüsslerstr. Formerly in LSS.M. Friend of BRÖKER and POLZFUSS. Considered by BRÖKER as likely source for D2 forms. FLEGEL called on SIEGEL on 1 Sep 46, but he denied that he was in a position to supply D2 forms, or that he knew of any source. FLEGEL told him about ZELLER and he expressed a desire to meet him. FLEGEL advised him to meet ZELLER at ZELLER in BREMEN on 2 Sep 46.

HALBURG. Employed by WERNHILDER as a driver. Close friend of DE CHELLARD and acquaintance of DUSCHEK.

(See DIC FR 111).

EDDELSTORF nr ALTEMEDINGEN. Contact of Hilge SCHLEIFER. FLEGEL called on TEGELER on 20 Jun 46 to meet SCHLEIFER. Knows HAUER

SÜDERMOLL. Farmer. FLEGEL stayed with THIESSEN on 10 and 11 Jul 46.

63. WEBER, Peter SS Ostuf
@ GÜNTHER

LÜBECK Police Stn. Home: LÜBECK, Wachenitzerstr 8. Formerly in Div FRUNDSBERG. Employed with Schupo in LÜBECK. Friend of EWERT. After capitulation succeeded in obtaining discharge as a Fw of the Wehrmacht, which in turn enabled him to join the police. He assisted other former SS men to enter the police force, including HAHN and BRÜKER. FLEGEL was introduced to WEBER by EWERT as a likely source for an SS typewriter. FLEGEL met HAHN and OLMEN at WEBER's flat on 2 Aug 46. FLEGEL met WEBER on several occasions. WEBER forged an SS document for FLEGEL on behalf of JACOBS. He asked FLEGEL on 23 Aug 46 and again on 5 Sep 46 to obtain a D2 form for OLMEN. WEBER informed FLEGEL on 29 Aug 46 that ZELLER had been suspended from duty owing to his former membership of the Allg SS.

64. WEIBEL, Frau Lilly

SEEG nr FÜSSEN. Friend of Frau WOLTER. Frau WOLTER advised ZELLER to visit Frau WEIBEL (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 76).

65. WEIHRAUCH, Frau, Frau

HAMBURG-ALTONA. Refugee from SILESIA. Contact of DUSCHKE, WERNITZLER and SIEGEL.

66. WERNITZLER, Max Bannf HJ

HOLZMIDEN. Close friend of DE CHELLARD. Employs SIEGEL as driver.

67. WOLTER, Frau Lotte

ALBERSDORF, Friedrichstr 11. Widow of Walter WOLTER, RAD Leader, who was assassinated in Apr 46 in a wood nr ALBERSDORF. FLEGEL called on Frau WOLTER on 15 Jun 46. She introduced him to EDEL, LUMITSCH and SCHOLZ. FLEGEL told Frau WOLTER and her guests of DE CHELLARD's political intentions. FLEGEL called again on 6 Jul 46, saw EDEL and LUMITSCH, and informed them of DE CHELLARD's arrest. Frau WOLTER obtained a typewriter for FLEGEL, on which he completed one of the D2 forms he had received from KÖHNKE. On 31 Aug 46 FLEGEL gave ZELLER Frau WOLTER's address in order that ZELLER could ascertain whether EDEL was still in a position to supply identity cards. Beg Sep 46 Frau WOLTER advised ZELLER to visit Frau WEIBEL. OLMEN told FLEGEL on 6 Sep 46 that he intended to see Frau WOLTER to obtain identity papers from EDEL for himself and for a friend (see also Personalities Appendix to DIC FR 111, No 80).

MÜNSTERDORF. Contact of GALLA and DE
CHELARD. Was present at a meeting in
HOLMSEN's flat in May 46.

69. ZELLER, fnu SS Mann

Hauptwachmeister, LÜBECK Police. Aug 46
was suspended from duty and subsequently
arrested owing to his former membership
of the illg SS. On 31 Aug 46 called on
SCHÄFER in HAMBURG to see FLEGEL. He
told FLEGEL that he had been released,
but that he considered it wise to leave
LÜBECK. FLEGEL gave him the address of
Frau WOLTER and advised him to find out
from her whether it was still possible
