1. A recent defector, DS-167, identified IDEN A as vulnerable to a Western approach (see pages 3 to 5 in Reference A attachment. IDEN A, a subordinate of [] is head of the Laser Laboratory at the Institute (IDEN B) of the East German Academy of Sciences. He is also a member of the Forschungsrat's Special Commission on lasers. While KUKNOB's interests in respect to lasers and masers is focused primarily on the Soviet Union, a routine effort is made to keep abreast of developments in the satellite countries, including East Germany.

2. An effort to establish contact with IDEN A appears worth your examination if only because IDEN A is a member of the East German technical intelligentsia. By virtue of his connections to the Forschungsrat's commission he probably has general insight into East German work in relatively new and sophisticated fields of technology. Furthermore, he has travelled to the Soviet Union (June 1963) and Czechoslovakia (October 1962) and may have been able to obtain some information on laser work performed in these countries. Moreover, as he is connected with an Academy of Sciences institute in Berlin and is also a specialist in photomultipliers and image inverters, it is quite possible that he has access--or can develop access--to the Rahnsdorf Institute of the Academy near Berlin, which is known to

specialize in infrared and other military and classified research.

3. Through his friend and former colleague (IDEN C) it may be possible to obtain advance notification whenever IDEN A plans to visit West Germany or Western Europe, at which time either DS-167 or IDEN C could introduce a KUBARKer for a positive intelligence debriefing. Judging from the description given by DS-167, IDEN A will be quite susceptible to such an approach. Please note that he knew of DS-167's impending defection and even considered defecting to the West himself.

4. This dispatch should be read in conjunction with Reference B, which is also based in part on information provided by DS-167.




