Extract from a memorandum for the record of a conversation between the DCI and General Gehlen, Chief of the West German Intelligence Service which took place in Frankfurt, Germany on 27 August 1956. Filed: Policy

"14. Dulles asked Gehlen whether he had decided to send his daughter to the U.S. Gehlen replied that he hoped to do so in the second half of next year. No specific mention of support was made though I believe Gehlen must have recognized from the general tenor of the conversation a willingness to provide some."
