SUBJECT { GENERAL Operational/UPSWING  
SPECIFIC 1958 UTILITY Visit to Headquarters

1. The wedding date for [ ] would appear to be the fact ultimately governing the timing of a 1958 UTILITY visit to the U.S. The date of her return to Germany was indefinite when I last saw her in New York City. In a recent telephone conversation with me she confirmed her intention of spending the entire Christmas holidays with us but made no further statement regarding her travel plans. She knows that I am traveling to Europe at the end of January and at one point talked about timing her own trip to coincide with mine. UTILITY may have more recent information on this point.

2. I can personally work up no enthusiasm at all for the idea of Hertel accompanying UTILITY --- particularly since we expect to pretty well use up our ammunition on the comptroller question on the @Kuehne, @Wendt and von Streit visit in January.

3. I will not be back until the end of February according to my tentative plan and would not recommend an early March date for UTILITY's trip. In fact, since he saw Ascham so recently in Germany, I have hoped that we could delay UTILITY's next visit until late spring at the earliest. I suspect that at this point a good deal of this iceberg remains hidden below the water, since [ ] once murmured something about UTILITY coming to New York prior to her departure. All of this leaves us very much up in the air, but I will write you again after I pin [ ] down on her plans.

By the latter I mean simply the fact that there are many things that KUBARK will openly discuss with UTILITY which we would not undertake to discuss with anyone outside of the profession --- and this has nothing to do with security.
