1. 29 MAY 1972 SPIEGEL HAD TWO AND HALF PAGE SHARP  
 CONDEMNATION OF ENGLISH VERSION GEHLEN MEMOIRS WHICH ALLEGEDLY  
 CONTAIN INFORMATION NOT PUBLISHED IN GERMAN VERSION AND SOME OF  
 WHICH COULD FALL UNDER SECRETS ACT. BASIC STORY IS THAT AFTER  
 WORLD PUBLISHING COMPANY PURCHASED WORLD RIGHTS FOR MEMOIRS IN  
 SEPTEMBER 1971, COMPANY HAD DAVID I R V I N G GET TOGETHER  
 WITH GEHLEN TO DRAW HITHERTO UNPUBLISHED DETAILS AND EVENTS  
 FROM RECESSES GEHLEN'S MIND. RESULT WAS THAT U.S. VERSION  
 INITIALLY, UP THROUGH PROOF STAGE, HAD NUMEROUS DETAILS,  
 INCLUDING NAMES, WHICH ULTIMATELY CENSORED FROM FINAL VERSION  
 BOOK. BURDEN OF SPIEGEL'S SONG IS THAT MUCH OF CENSORED IN-  
 FORMATION WAS STILL CLASSIFIED AND THAT GEHLEN MAY BE OPEN TO  
 PROSECUTION BY FEDERAL AUTHORITIES UNDER PARAGRAPH 353 B OF  
 THE STRAFGESETZBUCH, WHICH CARRIES SENTENCE OF UP TO FIVE  
 YEARS, FOR DIVULGING CLASSIFIED INFORMATION KNOWN TO HIM AS  
 A BEAMTER. FACT THAT HE GAVE IRVING DETAILS SUFFICES, COM-  
 POUNDED, ACCORDING TO SPIEGEL, BY FACT THAT SOME TWENTY  
 UNEXPURGED COPIES OF PROOFS FLOATING AROUND THE WORLD.  
 THESE HAD BEEN MADE AVAILABLE BY WORLD PUBLISHING COMPANY TO

2. MOST BRISANT DETAILS OF CENSORED MATERIAL ARE ACCORDING TO SPIEGEL -

A. CODENAME FOR ADENAUER'S STATE SECRETARY HANS GLOBKE WAS ''I-1783''.

B. GEHLEN HAD BND REPS SURVEILL EGON B A H R IN 1968 AFTER VISIT TO PULLACH AND SAW HIM MEET ITALIAN CP MEMBER.

C. GEHLEN ASKED F.B.I. TO INVESTIGATE COMMUNIST PAST OF BRANDT'S INTIMATE LEO B A U E R.

D. GEHLEN DECLARED PRESENT PRESIDENT OF BFV GUENTHER NOLLAU TO BE SECURITY RISK.

E. BND PRESIDENT GERHARD W E S S E L ''IS AN EXCELLENT NUMBER TWO MAN, BUT DOES NOT HAVE NECESSARY FORMAT TO HOLD IMPORTANT COMMAND FUNCTION''.

F. AT BEHEST OF C.I.A. CHIEF ALLAN DULLES, BND HAD HELPED BUILD UP EGYPTIAN INTEL SERVICE AND SLUICED FORMER SS-OFFICERS THERE TO TRAIN AND HOLD COMMAND POSTS.

G. AFTER SUEZ WAR OF 1956, BND TURNED SPECIAL INTEREST TO ISRAELI SERVICE AND GAVE ''FOREIGN AID'' TO THEM.

H. LATER TURNED TO EGYPT AGAIN AND, TO UNDERMINE SOVIET ROLE AND INFLUENCE, SET UP OWN DEPOTS FOR SOVIET SPARE PARTS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT.

I. MANAGED TO GET FRENCH SERVICE TO STOP REQUESTING LEADING WEST GERMAN PERSONALITIES TO REPORT ON INTERNAL GERMAN AFFAIRS.

J. WHAT, ACCORDING TO SPIEGEL, ALSO NEWS FOR FRIENDLY WESTERN SERVICES - ''THE BND UNMASKED THE DIRECTOR OF SOVIET ATOMIC ESPIONAGE - SERGEJ KUDRJAWZEW, LATER SOVIET AMBASSADOR /UNTIL SUMMER 1971/ TO CAMBODIA''.
