Dear Alec:

You may recall that way back in October 1954 you sent me information regarding subject indicating she had been dating one SYRUP who had been a very active SS man and that he may presently be working for a German organization. You also mentioned that GERRICH might be giving information to the local police and/or to SYRUP.

For your information I have just received reliable information that during the latter part of World War II she worked in Innsbruck with the Gestapo SD where she remained until February 1945 at which time she was sent to Verona to work for a positive intelligence group of the German SD as a typist.

This seems to tie in with the information you submitted and in all probability is again being utilized. In view of this you may want to review the entire situation and decide whether or not you wish to retain her. I feel you are the one in the best position to judge the seriousness of the problem and decide whether or not she should be retained. Please advise me of your decision.
