CASUSTAIN/15 had typewritten reports on AENOG's class of 18 June (Meeting A) and the farewell party of 25 June (Meeting B). (Note: Meetings had been held more frequently than usual in June in order to monitor AENOG's last days more closely.)

AENOG's wife told her that after the farewell parties, they would take a vacation in Mittenwald, Bavaria. (Note: Last party is on 27th. On night of 28 June, [redacted] as magazine salesman, determined that the AENOG's were not home.)

AENOG had photographs of his family, but as we expected, there was nothing in the photos to identify the place where they were taken, whether Irkutsk or Moscow. (Note: We should keep this in mind for the future. In all likelihood, AENOG's wife, if she comes out, will come alone, because children in these ages, cannot keep track of a cover story. If she is forced to come alone for this reason, there will be an immediate clash in family solidarity with professional duty, which might be exploitable.)

AENOG. In course of discussing beauties of Siberia, AENOG revealed that he is a mushroom and berry collector. He was able to discuss the types found in Siberia with some assurance. According to AENOG, the honey in Siberia is particularly good, since it is from an environment unspoiled by chemicals, etc.

AENOG's wife. AENOG's wife makes an unobtrusive first impression. She is about 5'3", hair graying. She has three gold front teeth. Her manner is friendly, modest and very calm. CASUSTAIN/15 had the impression that she had been warned or given special instructions about CASUSTAIN/15 from the way that her glance rested on CASUSTAIN/15. AENOG's wife speaks English with a Russian accent, but with extensive vocabulary. She was never at a loss for correct word. She learned none of her English overseas, all at home. She will resume her place as an English teacher when she returns. She got very little chance to go out while they were in Germany, and her German was terrible. Their son is Alexey (Alyosha). The daughter Darya (Dasha) had no German friends and also got out very seldom. Dasha had been looking forward to the party days. Upon CASUSTAIN/15's remark that it was not a prison, AENOG's wife said that she had gotten a good rest for the work to come. She had gone shopping. She found the self-service shops very simple. The daughter made an excellent impression on CASUSTAIN/15, a happy, friendly child without any fears, apparently on good terms with Herr Nilius.

Nilius, who was at the party, told AENOG that he could keep the book he was reading "Sprache der Politik" which Nilius had lent him. (First indication that Nilius was this close to him.
