1. Hq DAD 21 Jan 1. Reference is made to your IRS, file and subject as  
 66th LO 1952 above, dated 19 September 1951; and to your IRS, control  
 CIC file number 4809, subject: Frantisek WAINZ, dated 30 August  
 Det 1951.

2. Investigation conducted by this office to date indicates that SUBJECT is, and has been for the past several months, in very poor financial condition. There are also indications that GEIPEL is in debt in an amount variously estimated at between 1,600 and 2,000 DM.

3. In view of the information contained above and in your referenced IRS dated 30 August 1951, it is requested that this organization be informed of the evaluation placed by your organization on the information contained in paragraph 2d, your IRS dated 19 September 1951, and any other paragraphs which might be affected.

4. No indications of intelligence activities on the part of SUBJECT have been disclosed to date.
