Worked in Criminal Police before war, then was sent by Germans to Latvia for police service. Rejoined Kripo at end of war, was dismissed in 1945 ~~for reasons~~ because of service in Latvia.

Was recommended by [] and recruited by [] who used him only occasionally for routine police checks, for visas, etc. Security of meetings was good. Subject was originally recommended for Iceberg work, but dropped because of his casual work habits and lack of drive. He has still been used only occasionally for routine checks of files on personnel of interest to the station, a task which requires little imagination or skill. Contact with him at present is so slight that no progress report is currently being submitted. Costs: PX supplies, and actual costs of the job he is on. Motivation: anti-Commie sympathies. Recommend: retain contact if subject is still of enough use to warrant it. Otherwise, drop.
