SUBJECT: George GERBEKOV, aka Gralin.

1. Subject was born in 1908 at Novo-Tscherensk in Russia. He fled from Russia in 1920, lived in Yugoslavia until 1928, when he went to Paris. He worked there with the Russian opera and ballet, presumably until 1936, when he went to Germany to engage in stage work.

2. We would appreciate having Mr. Paul TSCHLITSCHEFF interviewed with respect to subject. TSCHLITSCHEFF is a Russian emigre painter who was naturalized 6 December 1945 in New York, at which time he resided at 360 E. 55th St., New York City. We desire information bearing on subject's residence in Paris and any political activity he may have engaged in while there. Any knowledge TSCHLITSCHEFF may have about subject's wartime activities will be useful.
