REF: Our Conversation of 21 June 1955

1. We have been informed, based on the reports of a source with contacts among the various emigre groups in Germany, that the following rumors concerning Subject are being circulated:

a. GIMZAUSKAS is allegedly trained and ready to depart for some non-Soviet zone in Austria as an intelligence agent. His wife is traveling with him. His departure for Austria is scheduled for approximately 1 July 1955.

b. GIMZAUSKAS and his wife have been trained by some intelligence organization for repatriation to Lithuania.

2. The date of this information is May and June 1955; it is evaluated F-3.

3. The first report would almost certainly seem to pinpoint the planned activities of Subject. While we are unable to estimate the number of persons within the emigration to whom this story is known, it can be assumed to be fairly large; surely past experience indicates that such reports circulating among the emigration sooner or later come to the attention of enemy intelligence services.

4. Could you please advise us of the results of Bureau Bavaria's investigation of Subject with regard to the statements he may have made concerning his future work for the Org.
