ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

1. The LNREAD L/O has provided the following information on several recently-reported members of CATUSK Military Auswertung (III.C).

a. @ROCHUS

born ca. 1934-1939

Believed to be a Captain assigned to the Army section. He assists @VERHOVEN (Satellites OB) and is interested primarily in the Czech army and the Central Group Forces (CGF). Ca. 5'11" tall; nondescript features; light-brown hair, parted in middle; wears dark-rimmed glasses. Single. Speaks fair English.

b. @METTER

born ca. 1937-1940

A German Air Force officer, rank unknown, he has given two briefings on the political aspect of East Bloc activities and is believed to assist @GRIFFITH. Subject was in the U.S. circa 1966-1967, at which time he visited several USAF installations including air academies at Montgomery, Ala. and Colorado Springs, Colo. Ca. 6'2" tall, dark hair, handsome, well-groomed. Subject claims to be one of the few true Bavarians on the Military Auswertung staff. Resides in Tutzing. Granted SIGINT clearance per EGMA-72505, 10 Apr 69.

c. @KONSTANZ

born ca. 1920

Army Lt. Colonel. Apparently the administrative chief of Military Auswertung, Subject heads the "Organization" Referat. Has large nose, small eyes, thick grey hair; is well-groomed and pleasant.

born ca. 1926
Possibly a non-commissioned officer, Subject's area
of interest is Hungary. Ca. 5'10" tall; wears clear-rimmed
glasses.

2. The LNRBAD L/O also reported that #GRIFFITH ^R ^W
claims to stem from Latvia. He speaks practically flawless English,
which he said he learned from an older sister, who graduated from
Cambridge and taught the other children at home, where there were
family days for English, Russian and French.

3. A bit more information on #GRIFFITH and some on #VERHOVEN
is contained in the attached copy of EGFA-48664, 24 June 69, of
which Headquarters did not get a copy.
