SPECIFIC- Assignment of Code Name

Ref : MBS-A-2902 (not fwd MOB); MOB-A-8264.

1. Subject of MOB-A-8264, a defection target, has been assigned the code name CAUTERY-5.
2. The operation is being handled by CAUTERY-1 and CAUTERY-2.
3. The original lead was provided by identity 1, who introduced CAUTERY-1 and CAUTERY-2 to identity 2. The latter knows subject personally and, under our instructions as conveyed to him by CAUTERY-1 and CAUTERY-2, is directly charged with subject's defection.
4. Case officer is in touch with CAUTERY-1 and CAUTERY-2 only. Neither he nor the organization he represents are known to identity 1 or 2.
5. The operation does not primarily aim at subject's outright defection, but is designed to develop him into a controlled source.
6. Expenses will be charged to Project CAUTERY.
7. A detailed report on operational measures involved is being prepared.
