Evaluation and date of info not mentioned.</p> <p>VERBATIM</p> <p>The reactionary attitude of the Bonn Government...is undoubtedly influenced by the individuals who have managed to enter the higher levels of the Federal administration, and especially the Interior Ministry, to date. While you may already have obtained this information from other sources, I would like to list here once more briefly some of the more objectionable individuals holding high Federal positions:</p> <p><u>Dr. Hans GLOBKE</u>, Personnel and Civil Service Advisor to Chancellor ADENAUER, formerly Oberregierungsrat in the Reich Interior Ministry during the HITLER regime and author of the official commentary on the Nuernberg laws (published by the Beksche Verlagbuchhandlung, Munchen, 1935).</p>
