UTILITY has advised 28 May that UPGROWTH cannot for political reasons proceed with intelligence matters more rapidly than with rearmament; thus action by UPTHRUST on the OIS will probably await ratification of the West German and EDC pacts. GLOBKE will visit POB 9 June and discuss the ZIPPER/UPGROWTH problem with us. He has, during the past month, completed his personal inspection of all major field installations of ZIPPER. We discount any rumors that he aspires to be head of a OIS; he has broader interests.
