MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director for Intelligence

SUBJECT: Proposed Visit of Dr. Hans GLOBKE to the United States

1. Dr. Hans Globke, State Secretary in the Chancellery of the German Federal Republic, will probably accompany Chancellor Adenauer when the latter visits this country in June to receive an honorary degree at Harvard University. Globke plans to leave the Chancellor's party on arrival in the United States and come to Washington as the guest of CIA. The tentative date of his visit is some time between the 7th and the 19th of June. The Director has stated that he will be pleased to meet Dr. Globke.

2. We assume that you will want to talk to Globke while he is here. Since we are preparing a tentative agenda for the discussions with him, I would appreciate knowing how much time you desire with Globke. It is also suggested that he might be briefed by [] of ONS, along lines similar to those of the briefing given the German parliamentary committee which was here in April.
