BACKGROUND AND ACCESS OF AGENT: Subject is a former high-ranking SS-officer who offered his services as a penetration asset of the National Democratic Party (NPD). His background during the Nazi period undoubtedly will make him attractive to the NPD, but there are also a number of war crime matters which might possibly still haunt him. We are attempting to establish his bona fides through SGSWIRL and other means at the earliest opportunity.

TYPE OF AGENT COMMUNICATIONS:

The agent has a telephone number of a cover unit in Frankfurt, through which messages are relayed to the case officer. No other means of communications have been established so far.

TARGETING: (including OD citation) Priority B, Subparagraph A. If this ever becomes an active operation, Subject will be [redacted] against the national leadership of the NPD.

OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS: (include security aspects and training)

Subject was last met in May 1968. During this meeting we learned that there is little likelihood that he will ever come to trial because of his background. A meeting had been scheduled for July 1968, at which time we had hoped to administer an SGSWIRL examination. Subject called off this meeting because of illness. We hope to meet with him in late October 1968, to administer the SGSWIRL examination. We also plan to have the Station medical officer along to attempt to verify his previous claim of illness.
