Subject does not smoke and drinks very little. He takes medication (tranquilizers) for his medical condition. As far as is known, he does not use any other drugs. Subject maintains a relationship with one of the tenants in his house (see Section XV below).		
8. COURT RECORD (Court, date, arrests, charges, punishments, sentences, acquittals)		
Subject was a prisoner of U.S. and French military forces from 1945 to 1950 in Freilassing, Bamberg, Wiesbaden, Schwarzenborn, Darmstadt, Dachau and Innsbruck. The imprisonment resulted from his membership in the SS and his role in the destruction of an underground radio station in Czechoslovakia, and his participation in the Venlo affair, which resulted in the death of a Dutch intelligence officer. Between 1963 and 1968 Subject was under investigation by German courts for his participation in war crimes. In 1968 all charges against him were dropped and the case dismissed due to lack of sufficient evidence and the statute of limitation.		
Subject has never been found guilty of anything or sentenced by any court.
