KASA-5184, 27 April 1959

1. In reducing the bulk of its files, Salzburg Operations Base has discovered that LZ/DE files numbering 21 through 42 cannot be processed in the usual way (see reference) and must be reduced photographically. Field facilities are not adequate for this work, so Headquarters is asked to have it done.

2. Microfilm of LZ/DE's 31 through 41 is forwarded as Attachment 1 (Under Separate Cover). Please reproduce all maps and charts on this film on an 8"x10", fine weight, mat paper (Attachment 2 is a sample of a German variety). To take maximum advantage of space, no margins or borders should be allowed. The photographic layouts, to be legible, will have to be reproduced on paper perhaps three or four times larger than that required for maps and charts; the exact size will have to be determined through experiment. These larger reproductions of photographic layouts can then be properly trimmed and folded in the field. (We are using 8"x11" envelopes as LZ/DE folders.)

3. The maps and charts in LZ/DE folders 1 through 30 were reduced in size by trimming and folding the negative photostats in our files (12 1/2"x17 1/2" before trimming). (Presumably these photostats are the same as those which Headquarters offered to copy for SOB in KASA-12, 16, 12 October 1958.) However, the negative copies of the photographic layouts, very large and difficult to read, were replaced by positive prints provided by ORLAUNCH-2 when originally submitted to the folders.

4. We do not have microfilm copies of LZ/DE folders 21 through 30 but have large positive, actual size photostats which are impossible to reduce in size by trimming. We request that Headquarters reproduce their copies of these LZ/DE folders in the size and format requested for LZ/DE's 31 through 42 in paragraph 2. above.

5. Forwarded as Attachment 3 (Under Separate Cover) is LZ/DE 42 a and b submitted by ORLAUNCH-2 in the Fall of 1958. Please reproduce this in the same manner in which folders 21 through 30 are reproduced.

6. When SOB receives the copies requested in the above paragraphs, the original ORLAUNCH-2 folders 31 through 41 and the large photostats 21 through 30 will be destroyed.
