1. EUCA can conduct the training requested; we prefer the last week of September.
2. Relative to the field exercise:
  - a. Request ARB obtain suitable camp site--free as possible from scrutiny by Forstant Officials.
  - b. It is recommended strongly that a representative of ARB accompany the Agent and Training Officer on the field exercise.
  - c. With the exception of the Training Officer's ruck sack, sleeping bag and air mattress, ARB will be required to furnish the necessary camping gear. It is suggested that a 2-3 man tent be provided to ensure suitable work space and necessary concealment of our activity. Rations, water and stove should also be furnished.
  - d. The EUCA Training Officer will bring the necessary radio equipment in addition to all personal items required for the camp-out.
3. One point not mentioned in reference is the contemplated site for the initial review training. In interests of time, it is suggested that this phase of the training be conducted in a safe facility in close juxtaposition to the field exercise location.
