## GERMAN ATROCITIES

### MAIN GREECE

EXECUTIONS The following were court martialled and executed:-

- On the 7/1/43 Aristidis Tsoulis
- On the 28/1/43 Const. Papadopoulos & Angelos Karakatsanis.
- On the 3/2/43 Ilias Alevizakis, Avrilios Varkados and Vassilios Ioannidis
- On the 12/7/43, Panayottis Pakoutsis, Andreas Seimenakis, Mavroudis Baltas, Mihail Stamatakis and Georgios Pavlatos.
- On the 23/8/43, Const. Rapantas, Georgios Sotiropoulos, Vas. Fasoulas, Grigorios Bouloutsis, Christos Ekmetzoglou, Ioannis Mermikidis and Panayottis Hrisanthakopoulos.

17 civilians detained in the Averoff prisons, 4 gendarmes detained in the Syngrou prisons and 6 children were executed in Kessariani, Athens, on the 28/8/43

Mihail Makridis, Const. Kapousidis, Antonios Arvanitis, Dionissios Grammenos and B. Theofilou were executed on the 9/10/43

Panayotouos, merchant and Kilakos, Commissioner accused of illegally selling olive oil were hanged towards the end of October in the America square, Athens.

K. Bouloubassis, Dimitrios Manos, Nicolas Panagopoulos were executed on the 16/10/43

The following were executed on the 2/11/43 in Athens:- Eudokimos Klawdis, Alex Kairis (mentioned in our Bull. C. 38- as arrested) Const. Makris, Theo. Kekkeris, Loukas Tsoutsas, George Samaras and Evang. Papadas.

Theo. Ghavalas, Dim. Vidalis, Theo. Zeppos, Ioannis Kolivis, Vassilios Milidis, were executed on the 6/11/43.

Panayottis Banachi, was executed on the 24/11/43

Spyr. Kassimatis, Vas. Tzavaras, Dim. Frangos, Ioannis Kolivis, Ioannis Meltonis and Ioannis Monas, were executed on the 25/11/43.

and two others.

On the 6/12/42:- Emm. Zervas, Gerassimos Kalitsis, Michael Laoudis, Stavros Grigoropoulos were executed on the 6/12/42.

A further 10 persons were executed on the 12/12/42, because a German soldier had been wounded.

In July 1943, in Alsos Pangratiou (Athens), 10 men were being taken to the execution ground, on their way there, one of them succeeded in escaping. The German guards immediately arrested a pedestrian whom they executed in order to complete the number of 10. The Athens Metropolitan Bishop, protested to the German authorities for this, who nevertheless admitted the action taken by the guards as justified.

MURDERS The Germans after the surrender of the Italian guard of Levidia on the 10/9/42, arrested all inhabitants aged 15 and on without any exception and shooting anybody attempting to resist or escape. They, thus killed student Pelekanos or Kalkoutas.

Five peasants, sitting on the porch of Aghios Georgios church were attacked by a German patrol and Miltiadis Eotirhenas, landowner, who attempted to escape was killed. The other 4 locked up in a house together with the 80 year old owner, and killed with grenades

Kadi and Zaghora quarters of Levidia town were burnt to the ground.

On the 14/9/43, 30 peasants from a village near Levidia were arrested as hostages and one of them was executed.

In September 1943, German detachments attacked Villia village which they looted, burning many houses. Many innocent peasants were executed on the spot. The number of victims and names is not yet known.

IMPRISONMENTS Barrister Maritona Papadimitriou was sentenced by the German Martial Court of Athens to 10 years imprisonment for spying. Together with a priest they were tortured so much that on the third day their hair turned white.

ARRESTS Emmanuel Priftis was arrested with 9 of his comrades at Liopessi (Attiki) in June 1941 and were detained for 30 days in the Averoff prisons, Athens, for having cut German telephone wires.

7 persons were arrested on the 11/12/41 for attempting to escape to the U.E. Papagrigorakis, leader of the group was beaten and tortured.

Mrs. Papadopoulos was arrested in Athens and sent to prison during 1943, because a wireless set was found in her house. Another 8 women are being held in the same prisons.

The following were arrested in Athens in October 1943, 1) Vatikiotis, head of a department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and his wife 2) Vas. Coumas, shipowner, released 20 days later. Mrs. Vatikiotis, is detained in the women's isolation prisons.

Some 200 civilians were arrested in the Galasti quarter of Athens in October 1943, because 4 German soldiers were found murdered. A few days later, they were released because it was proved that the 4 Germans were killed during an engagement.

ILL-TREATMENTS In October 1941 a German patrol at Liopessi (Attiki), ill-treated the 3 daughters of Haralambos Hounta, because a light was showing from their rooms at night.

Lykidis and N. Korakis, tram driver were beaten mercilessly by 2 German soldiers in November 1941, in Athens, because they refused to take the Germans to their base after all passengers had got off the tram.

In December 1941, a German soldier kicked a Greek invalid in Pireaus, wounding him severely because he tried to enter the tram through the door in which the German was standing.

On the 28/12/41, in Pireaus, a German 2nd/Lt. beat a young child because it picked up a sweet which had been thrown before the German's feet.

On the 3/2/43, at Perama (Pireaus) a German soldier wounded a worker with a M.G. because he cut wood for his use.

British prisoners being taken through Athens on the 12/10/43 were cheered by the population enthusiastically. The Germans attacked the crowd and wounded many of them.

A meeting of employees at the issuing Bank of Athens was dissolved by the Germans. Of those present Mrs. Hristoforidou Mariati, Ziha Polyzakis, Piggliaris and Stomos were wounded and the following were arrested 1) Theo. Tourkovassilis, bank director, released a few days later on 2) Kalimeris 3) Pouskouris 4) Th. Papageorgiou 5) Fani Papageorgiou 6) Mavrakis 7) Mrs. Mavrakis 8) Mrs. Sismanof 9) Kriton Eleftheriadis, I. Bourmias, I. Chemenakis and Mrs. Ioanna Valergha and Lada were searched. Th. Papageorgiou was tortured.

ACTS OF ARSON Kastrion (Fthiotis) village was set on fire on the 24/4/43, Moshckaria was set on fire on the 3/4/43, Heraida on the 5/5/43, Pelasghia on the 25/4/43, Dilofof on the 27/6/43, Androu on the 25/4/43, Glifa on the 6/3/43, Makri on the 28/8/43, Palathohorio on the 29/4/43, Kallithea on the 27/6/43, Divri on the 25/4/43.

The villages of Dio Vouna (Fthiotis), Skarfia (Lokris) Ematia and Livanates were partly burnt down.

The following villages were burnt down in the Levadia area:- Zaghora, Etirion, Koukoura, Desfina, Stevelikon, Efaka, Monastery Ossia Louka. The villages Zarikion and Zeli were completely destroyed.

Kriomeri and Koudouni villages were burnt to the ground in the Etoloakarnania area. Roumoussika, Spolaika, Sykia, Flories, Roupaika, Agh. Trianta, Anixiatiko, Damanta, Varghiani, Polidrosson, Kastelia, Marghiolata, Sernikaki, Erallios, Agh. Constandinos, Kaloskopi, Inohorion, Fghition (Doris) Mikrohorio, Marathi and D. Stenora were partly burnt down.

In the Pierria area Litchori village.

The following villages were partly destroyed :- Leptokaria, Kato Lylia, Aghios Dimitrios, Kalipefki, Pyrghitos, Palyopyrges, Augani.

In September 1943, German detachments burnt the villages of Vraila and Mavrighiani (Lidorikion area) to the ground in reprisal for the murder of German soldiers near the Skevo river. They arrested the women and children of these villages and interned them in the Rouf Concentration camp, Athens.

Matsouki village (Akarnania) was burnt to the ground during the same month.

On the 7/10/43, Lilea village (Parnassos) was burnt down by German detachments in reprisal for Guerillas activities. 750 of the inhabitants of the village escaped to the mountains. Only the old or unfit remained in the village and were all killed by the Germans.

Eptalofos village (Ano Aghoriani) suffered the same fate. 600 inhabitants escaped to the mountains. 36 old and sick who remained behind were killed by the Germans.

AraNova town was partly burnt down.

The tragic conditions of the inhabitants of these gutted villages is undescrivable.

Several thousands of innocent peasants without housing and starving hide in caverns.

EXECUTIONS Three persons were executed in Nafplion in August 1943.

MURDERS The market town of Arahova (Lakonia) was burnt down after being looted in September 1943. - 10 inhabitants arrested as hostages were executed because Greek Guerillas had passed through the town on the previous day.

From information dated December 1943, we learn that the Germans executed 150 hostages in Monodendri village in reprisal for Guerilla activity in the area.

In December 1943, inhabitants of Kalavrita were tortured in reprisal for Guerilla activity in the area. Kalavrita was burnt down. From the 3.000 houses only 6 escaped complete destruction. In the town 1300 innocent inhabitants were shot and 50 hanged.

ARRESTS In September 1943, 150 intellectuals and employees were arrested as hostages in Patras and threatened to be shot. Amongst them are :-

AGIS OF ARSON The following villages of Ahaia were partly burnt down in September 1943:- Ano and Kate Lousse, Vrahni, Aghia Paraskevi, Kalentzi, Valimahi, Aghia Marika, Lapaka, Petsaki.

Treklistra and Soudehi are reported to have been completely destroyed.

In the Meghaloupolis area, German detachments burnt 4 villages in reprisal for Guerilla activity.

Routsli village was burnt to the ground by German soldiers.

German detachments burnt the monasteries of Megha Spyleon and Aghia Lavra to the ground, in reprisal for Guerilla activity.

All villages round Kalavrita were burnt to the ground.

THESSALY

MURDERS - In June 1943, German Units executed 7 peasants and raped many girls all relatives of Guerillas in Ikaria village (Olympos) in reprisal for Guerilla activity.

- In Olympias they murdered 2 peasants. One of them was found with a knife stuck in the chest and with the eyes torn out. 3 girls all sisters of Guerillas were raped.
- In Poliana 5 women and 6 men were killed.
- In Skamia 4 men were murdered.
- In Sparkos and Kokkinoplo, 2 men and 9 women were killed.
- In Mitsouni, 4 men
- In Selos, 2 men.
- In Santovo, 12 men

All the above villoges with the exception of Sellos were burnt to the ground after being looted.

Six inhabitants of Demazi village and 6 from Christa village were murdered by the same German detachments. These 2 villoges were burnt to the ground.

On the 15/8/43, in Kanalia village, Trikala area, whilst the inhabitants were gathered in the Church, many german planes bombed the village, killing the following :-

over 30 were wounded.

In September 1943, 3 gendarmes were arrested and executed in Larissa without trial, for being members of an armed band.

The terrorist activities of the German security corps in Larissa and generally in the towns and villoges in Thessaly are on an ever increasing scale (Bull.C.41).

Arrests, murders, and ill-treatments are daily occurrences. It is reported that in the end of September 1943, some 24 civilians were executed in Larissa without reason or trial. Amongst them were 4 women and a child 11, who was executed together with his father.

In September 1943, Gaura village was burnt down. Two inhabitants, Tsimas and Davelis who remained in the village owing to their age, were burnt alive. The remainder had taken refuge in the nearby hood, but were discovered by the germans and 65 were executed on the spot without distinction of age or sex. 9 members of the Manakia family were murdered and 6 from the Goudou. Amongst the victims are, Glikeria, Cheyou, aged 60 and Yanakena Nicoloudi aged 90. Helen Lahanaki was found dead with both feet cut off.

Porfiri, wife of the tax inspector of Kalambaka, and another woman went to Kastaria (Kalambaka) village in order to buy food but the Germans there, murdered them.

Germans on entering Krania village found 3 persons who had remained to beg the germans to spare the village which was peaceful and had nothing to do with the Guerillas. Not only were all their efforts in vain, but they also were burnt alive in the village. Only a man by the name of Saravouka, managed to escape.

All inhabitants of Kalambaka who did not succeed in escaping, were arrested by the Germans and executed on the spot.

The bodies of Christos Sakellaridi, Barrister, 60 years old, Papadimitriou, landowner, 60 years old and 3 others old men were found by villagers on the 18/10/43. They had been executed outside Kalambaka because they participated in Guerilla groups.

The bodies of two peasants, identity unknown were found outside Kastraki village.

ARRESTS From information dated December 1943, we learn that the Germans arrest all male inhabitants aged from 20-30 years in Thessaly, sending them to compulsory labour camps in Ekaterini. All aged from 30-40 are sent to work in the Katara tunnel.

The following villages were partly burnt down in the Trikala area:- Pyli, Pezoula, Kotroni, Hermanga, Theopetra, Agnantia, Tsougario and during September 1943:- Kerassia, Kakoplevri, Kipourio, Arapis and Meritsa.

During October 1943, German detachments burnt the following villages of Kalambaka area to the ground:- Metsovon, Korydallos, Trygona, Aidon, Pefki, Ghodovasda, Hrisades, Koutsoufliani and Malakassi.

At Malakassi, the Germans tortured and ill-treated all inhabitants who did not succeed in escaping. The sister of the merchant Papanikolaou who had remained behind because she was lame, was raped by 8 german soldiers.

Domiana village was looted and completely destroyed.

In Kalambaka area some 60.000 inhabitants are without housing and starving.

Some 1500 women and children found shelter in a cave near Diava village (Preventa) in order to escape from the german slaughterers. Six women aged 20-30 years died from hunger and cold but their companions kept the bodies for many days fearing discovery from nearby german detachments.

Herebelow, we give a list of villages and inhabited localities burnt down by the german detachments. The following were burnt to the ground :- Seskoulon, Karia, Skamnia, Toliana, Karaouli, Sadovon, Hiounari, Kelamani (Volos), Anavra, Ano, Makrilofos, Mancler, Tsifliki Sterghiou.

The following were set on fire but not completely destroyed :- Olympias, Sparhos, Zatar, Dryeskouro, Pairakli, Ambelia, Ano and Kato Satirli, Verdikoussa, Farmeki, Maghoulia, Kriovrissi, Pazaflades, Flamouro, Kokkinoplos, Pythion, Tsouhlitsa, Ghlikovon, Tsambakli, Aghios Dimitrios, Delini, Sarantaporon, Tsapournia, Vouvala, Yamitsa, Gherania, Petristo, Klissoura (Volos area): Lafkos, Tsangarada, Kofi, Vrinaki, Drimi.

E P I R U S

EXECUTIONS:- Georgios Ghiotis was executed in Amphotopo (Philippias) on the 19/9/43, for sabotage.  
9 persons were executed in Loutrotopi (Arta) on the 30/9/43 in reprisal for sabotage.

MURDERS During September 1943, German units from Paramythias and Parghas burnt the following villages to the ground because Guerillas had been reported in these areas:- Kotka, Gliki, Potamia, Vouvopotamo, Nemitsa, Spatharea, Annoudia, Koronopoulos, Saliada. Armed moslems guided by the Germans looted the villages first and also killed 3 peasants.

On the 18/9/43, 12 inhabitants of Kombotiou and Sallades (Arta) returned to their destroyed villages in order to find food. The Germans arrested them and executed on the spot. Among them was a priest.

An engagement was fought on the 28/9/43 between Greek Guerillas and German detachments near Eleftherohori village (Paramythia). In reprisal, the German authorities helped by armed Albanians, arrested 49 notables of Paramythia and executed them without trial on the 30/9/43. Only the following names of the victims are known :- 1) Const. Siomopoulos, headmaster 2) Valaskaki, doctor 3) Skoutzalari, director of the agricultural Bank 4) Kusanakou, priest.

During September 1943, the Germans confined the inhabitants of Kastanohoria (Bpirus) in the houses, shooting anyone attempting to escape and they set fire to village. After Germans left some 40 bodies were found completely carbonised.

On the 18/10/43, German detachments burnt down Pades village and murdered Panagiotis Karanasson 47 years old and Yencoula Toska 70 years old.

In the Paleomelion village, they burnt 65 out of the 126 houses and killed Iliar Vassilikas aged 70.

From Distraton village, only 27 houses from the 220-escaped complete destruction. Nicolas Karayannis aged 70 and a woman were killed.

Maro Vyssa aged 67, her nephew Ilias aged 14 and 9 other women and children were killed when Melissopetra village was burnt down.

ACTS OF ARSON On the 20/8/43-15/9/43, the villages Artis Komboti Sallades and Limni, were burnt to the ground. 4.000 women and children of these villages are homeless and starving.

From 15/9/43-30/9/43, all the villages of Preveza area were burnt to the ground:- Valadoussa, Aidoni, Aheroussia, Vouvopotamos, Kastri, Loutsa, Aidonia, Markissos, Koukouli, Zarvina, Ano and Kato Despotikon, Aghios Georgios, Anoghion, Voulitsa, Panaghia. The inhabitants of these villages abandoning everything escaped to the mountains.

The following villages of Ioannina area were partly burnt down :- Rodotipi, Pizanion, and Aghia Kyriaki.

On the 20-25/9/43, the villages Limeni and Merarhi were burnt to the ground.

On the 1-5/10/43 Peronithi, Loutrotopi, Agrillos and Aliko villages were burnt down. Some 13.600 inhabitants are now homeless.

On the 18/10/43, German detachments burnt Eleftherohori village (Arta) to the ground. Pades village was completely destroyed.

Distraton and Paleonelion villages were burnt down. Between the 20-30/10/43, Germans attacked villages of Ioannina area: Fortazion and Augho were partly burnt down (40 houses were destroyed and 2 persons killed) half of Serviana was destroyed.

The villages Baoufa and Kontini were burnt to the ground. In Ellinikon village 55 houses were burnt to the ground.

Kontovrakion was partly burnt down.

75 houses of Kalmoutzion were completely destroyed, in Aetorhi 18, in Krapsi 5, in Anatoliki 30, in Mikra Gnapiota 100, in Mouzakious 10 and in Kyparissia 1 house. The Megha and Mikro Peristerion were burnt to the ground.

#### CENTRAL MACEDONIA

EXECUTIONS Aristidis Tonos, arrested in Lytilini was executed in Salonica during 1941 for spying.

During 1941, Athanassios Sikertzis, armourer from Paghirion was sentenced to death by Court Martial and executed in Salonica during 1941.

The following sentenced to death by the German Martial Court during 1942 and executed :- 1) Cleon Kendilakis, shoe maker 2) Christos Katsilakis, farmer 3) Georgios Armatzianis, farmer 4) Ioannis Leontaridis, farmer 5) Miltiadis Zahos 2nd/lieut. 6) Aristidis Kouvatzis, photographer 7) Christos Efstratiadis, student 8) Pashalis Bouras, farmer 9) Minas Tatsis.

The following were arrested whilst attempting to escape to the M.E. in December 1942 and executed. 1) Pan. Christodoulos 2) Const. Icomidis 3) Rangos 4) Const. Chatelis 5) G. Kougridis.

Fortounopoulos was executed in Salonica during 1943 for possessing arms.

Georgios Dyras and Nicolas Voloyannis arrested in Lytilini on the 20/5/43 (see Bull. No. 637) were tried in Salonica, sentenced to death and executed on the 19th 1943, for spying.

Evangelos Tataridis, worker, was executed during 1943.

Const. Kiosminoudis and Sarantis Lilitakis, shepherds, were executed during 1943 in Asvestades village.

52 persons were executed in Salonica as communists on the 13/1/44.

ARRESTS During October 1943, Edessa's German military police arrested 6 inhabitants as hostages.

PLUNDERERS From trustworthy information we learn that the Germans rob food in Salonica on the excuse that large quantities of food were found hidden. They search all houses and shops seizing even the smallest quantities of food necessary for the immediate needs of the owners. Some 50 persons were arrested during these raids for resisting against the Germans. All seized food stuffs were distributed to the occupation forces.

The Germans in Halkidiki and generally in the whole Macedonia have requisitioned all the wheat crop.

In November 1943, Greek workers at Verroia refused to load corn destined for Germany. The Germans fired on them, killing one and wounded 2. - 10 workers were arrested as leaders and are detained in Salonica's prisons.

On the 10/7/43, the inhabitants of Ghinckokastron village kilkis area, protested against the extension of the Bulgarian occupation. The Germans dispersed the manifestants and in reprisal imposed a heavy fine on the village, confiscating also the fortunes of property of Alex. Kyriakidis, Adam Tzambasaki, Const. Axonidou and Ath. Kehradaki considered the leaders of this manifestation.

The German authorities on the 12/7/43 imposed a fine of 20.000.000 Drs. on Meghali Vrissi village (Kilkis area), because the inhabitants protested and resisted against the Germans who were carrying off the corn crop. Const. Papadopoulos considered responsible for the manifestation had all his property confiscated.

WESTERN MACEDONIA

---

MURDERS 15 inhabitants of Florina were hanged during August 1943. Amongst them are:- Alex. Karamanlis, Kavolianis priest and Thomaidis.

5 others were hanged in Hympheon village. During September 1943, German detachments encircled Livadero village, locked all the villagers in their houses and then set fire to the village. All within, were burnt alive. Anyone succeeding in escaping from this fiery inferno was shot. Three small children were torn from the arms of their mothers and thrown into the fire.

ACTS OF ARSON In reprisal for Guerilla activities, German detachments burnt Vriovatonos village to the ground. Neapolis Polilakkos and Polidendron all of Kozani area, were partly burnt down.

Kraychori, Pentavrissi, Aghia Anna, Ano and kato Ptelia, Tsouna, Vitani, Aughi, Lefkovi and Kiliodendron all villages of Kastoria area were burnt to the ground. Kastarazi Tsakani and Kastorion villages were partly burnt down.

WESTERN THRACE

---

EXECUTIONS The following were sentenced to death by the German Martial Courts and executed in Didimotihon during 1942. Pan. Stefanakis and Ev. Gouzakis, farmers.

During 1942, Ilias Pafaras, farmer, was executed in Thracia and Ioannis Athanassiadis, bricker in Orestias.

The following were executed in Didimotihon in 1943.

ILL-TREATMENTS In order to terrorise the inhabitants, the Germans use planes in attacks on inhabited localities. On the 11/9/43, a German plane strafed the inhabited locality of Aliverion and its Port Karavos for 20 minutes. 2 inhabitants were wounded.

C R E T E

---

EXECUTIONS Georgios Tomazinakis and his son Matzis were arrested in the Pori village Canca area and executed in June 1941, after a short trial because they participated in the battle for Crete.

Mich. Stavrakakis and Tsouhlarakis Malepas are reported to be amongst 50 hostages executed in Kastelli (Pedias) in July 1943.

Archimandrite (Bishop) Rodotheos Tsagarakis, was arrested in Vassilia village (Pemenous area) on the 20/9/43, because he organised collections for the Guerilla groups and executed. Emmanuel Vidakis, Matheos Katsadakis, Iossif Kanakoussis and 2 others were arrested in September 1942 in Panaghia village for belonging to a Guerilla group and were executed in October 1943.

Dimitri Pronakis and Ioannis Pronakis, driver, were shot in Heraklion for National activity in September 1943.

Antonios Kastrinakis was executed in Zaro village (Kenouriou) in September 1943, for collaborating with the Guerillas.

Const. Samaritis, was arrested in Aghio Sylla and executed for National activity on the 10/10/43.

The following were sentenced to death by the German Martial Courts of Canea for belonging to National Organisations and executed in October 1943:-

2nd/Lt. Ioannis Zagrafakis was arrested in Kastelli (Pedias) in October 1943, sentenced to death and executed for helping Guerillas.

Emm. Tzisperakis in Nov. 1943, was executed for helping Guerilla groups.

MURDERS On the 20/6/41 Germans in Mournies (Mania), murdered the family of Miss Skoula who faced with this tragedy committed suicide.

Varipatakis aged 85, is amongst those executed in Alikion on the 1/8/41.

In October 1941, the President of Aghion village Community Georgios Katzias and Angelos Pouschakis, head of the telegraph office, were executed without trial because they did not hand over hidden Britishers to the Germans.

In June 1942, the German sergeant major Schubert, tortured and then murdered Emm. Karageorgakis in Rani Kastelli village, because he did not hand over his arms.

The following were murdered during 1942 by German detachments in Kroussoa :-

Dim. Vererakis, Const. Vamvakakis and G. Vererakis, were executed without trial during the same month for refusing to become organs of the secret german police.

Emm. Natheas, tortured by the Germans for national activity and for helping Britishers died from exhaustion on the 27/6/43, in Korfes (Heraklion).

The invalid Ioannis Mathenas was executed in Chonies village (Maleviziou) on the 16/8/43, without trial or reason.

Emm. Georgakakis was executed in Lavada village in August 1943 without trial for possessing arms.

Vassilios Kyrkimbiris, a peasant, was arrested and killed by German soldiers on the 6/8/43 in Amsha village for unknown reasons.

Michael Vrentzos, shepherd was arrested and executed on Mida mountain, by German soldiers on the 20/8/43. His herd of 200 sheep was carried off by his murderers.

On the 31/8/43, german soldiers in the Viannou area killed Dimokriton Arvanitakis, for collaborating with Guerilla groups.

In September 1943, a german detachment executed Eleftherion Spithouris and Kallergis in the Kato Horio village (Monofatsiou) because they had killed german parachutists during the 1941 operations.

On the 10-15/9/43, George Grigorakis was executed in "Gefiraki" Heraklion without trial because his brother happened to be a Guerilla leader.

On the 14/9/43, a german gestapo agent arrested gendarmierie W.O. Georgiou Frankakis in Embaron village (Heraklion), killed him and threw his body down a well where it was found by relatives 3 days later.

On the 14/9/43-16/9/43, german detachments looted the villages Hristos, Parsas and Malles. The following were executed in the Malles village on the 14/9/43 without trial :-

All the above were over 70 years of age and were accused for helping Guerillas.

On the 26/9/43, the german sergeant major Schübert and his detachment executed without trial in Varni Krousson area:- Filippos Makatounis, Const. Giannadakis and Georgios Vassilakis for helping the Guerilla movement. Georgios Houmas who had up to now collaborated with germans was also executed with the above for unknown reason.

The same detatment arrested and executed Georgios Kalispe-rakis and Ioannis Vassilakis outside Korfes village (Malevizion) G. Voulgharakis and Andreas Mathenas who were wanted were not found.

On the 29/9/43, German detachments encircled Koustogheraka village of Selinou eparay and arrested 50 w men, men and children and then lined them up and began executing them. 5 w men, 4 children and 6 old men were killed but a Guerilla Unit arrived in time to save the remainder.

The following were killed on the 29/9/43 during the bombing of Kostogherakos village:-

The following were also killed in the same month in Moni village 1) Ar. Stavrianoudakis 2) Antonios Stavrianoudakis 3) Dim. Stavrianoudakis 4) Emm. Vaghiakis 5) Widow Sifalaki Georgiou 90 years old 6) Aspasia Lambrousaki, 80 years thrown by the germans into her flaming house and burnt alive.

All the above were the only remaining inhabitants in the village and all were either sick or too old to follow the others who escaped to the mountains.

German soldiers outside Aghia Irini village killed Panayoti Paterakis and another peasant after compelling them to bury comrades.

The shepherds Michael Bertanis of Bambakado village (Kandanos), Varagakis and Georgios Frangakis were murdered. The 2 last were compelled to bring their sheeps to Kandanon before their execution.

Miss Siradaki aged 16 was wounded during the bombing of Livada village. The Germans took her under escort to Hania but on the way exhausted, she fell down unconscious. One of the Germans wanted to put her on a horse, but a quarrel between the 2 German guards took place and the other in anger emptied his pistol on the unconscious girl.

Siradaki family has yet another victim. Ioannis Siradakis aged 75 was the only remainder inhabitant of Livada village during the attack by the Germans. The old man who had remained in his home succeeded alone in killing the leading lieut. of the German detachment and in wounding 2 soldiers. He was killed only after having fired his last cartridge at the invaders.

Mary Siradaki, Amalia Tsouri aged 13 and Ioannis Papaderos aged 75 were executed on the same day in Livada village.

In October 1943, a German detachment killed the shepherd Bourdakis and his brother who rushed to help him in order to carry off their flock.

In October 1943, the German sergeant major Schubert and his detachment executed 11 civilians in Tzermiado, Laghos and Aghios Georgios villages because they did not have arms to hand over.

On the 4/10/43 German detachments burnt Kallikrati and Kaliskia villages in reprisal for Guerilla activity. They locked up 10 women in a house of the latter which they set on fire burning the women alive because their husbands were nowhere to be found.

On the 27/10/43, a German detachment in pursuit of Guerillas arrested all inhabitants of Douli village looking for arms. A savage beating followed.

From those arrested Const. Maniotekis suffered most.

On the same day they killed Em. Apoudolianakis from Aghios Thomas and the peasant Apostolos from Melidohori village.

This detachment under the command of sergeant major Schubert go round the island in pursuit of Guerillas. In reality they commit unbelievable crimes against the innocent inhabitants. Murders, violations and plunders are their daily program.

On the 4/11/43, 7 civilians were executed in Mismou village for belonging to National organisations.

On the 6/11/43, 6 civilians in Mismo and Krotos (Kainouria) villages were executed because they did not have any arms to hand over.

In November 1943, Germans and Italian fascists who joined with the Germans after Italy's collapse arrested Georgios Matzaki shepherd in Kamares village and executed him on the spot because he had taken his herd into a prohibited zone. Actually the proclamation declaring the area of Kamares village a prohibited zone was published a few days later.

ARRESTS Iossif Manis was arrested in Atsalenio (Heraklion) in February 1943 for National activity. He was sent to prison where he was ill-treated and released 52 days later.

In April 1943, Georgios Kastanakis, lieut. of cavalry, was arrested in Canca, court martialled, but released again as he was found innocent. A few days later on, he was stopped and searched by the German police but was not arrested.

In September 1943, 2nd/lieut. Dramintinos was arrested in Heraclion and was sent to prisons because he sheltered his wanted brother Nic. Dramintinos.

Ioannis Matzavakis was arrested on the 14/9/43 in Embaron village (Heraclion).

In September 1943, the following were arrested in the Heraclion area for National activity:- 1) Nicolas Plevris, Lieut. Col. 2) Major Katsirtakis 3) Kapsatzakis, lieut. Col. 4) Lieut. Koutsounadis. They were court martialled, found innocent and released 40 days later.

The following were arrested in Viannos area in October 1943 and detained for a month:- 1) Iracelis Dramintinos, shoe-maker 2) Const. Bitsakis, mason 3) Georgios Stavroulakis, farmer 4) Nic. Frangakis.

In October 1943, the Germans arrested the shepherd Michael Margharitakis, for helping Guerillas and confiscated his flock of 400 sheep.

Emm. Lambrakis, was arrested in Arkalohori on the 7/11/43 for belonging to a patriotic organisation.

The President of the Community of Malles village, Emm. Papadakis and the school teacher George Papadakis were arrested during November 1943 for having disarmed an Italian outpost and for supplying food to the Guerillas.

In December 1943, Brothers Antonios and Ioannis Astrinaki were arrested in Krousson village and sent to Heraclion prisons.

On the 7/12/43, Ioannis Valtzakis his wife and 3 children, Evang. Kalliyanakis, Filipos Valtzakis, his wife and son Karalambos were arrested in Krousson because a relative of theirs working in the German police station had attempted to escape to the M.E.

ILL-TREATMENTS In September 1943, German soldiers ill-treated the father and the sister of Katrikiki in Zaro (Kainouriou) because their relatives were Guerillas.

In November 1943, a German detachment encircled Apolygno village (Kainourion) in order to arrest Frangoulitis alias Skoutelis wanted for spying. Because they did not find him, they ill-treated all the inhabitants and looted the village. They arrested instead his brother in law Const. Ghiamboulaki and sent him to the Heraclion prisons.

In Crete the Germans carry out acts of terrorism in order to compel the inhabitants to enroll for compulsory labour. Gherakari (Amariou) Zoniana and Anoghia (Polypotamos) villages are those which have suffered most.

VIOLATIONS On the 22/5/41, a German soldier raped a young girl of Varipetra (Hania) village.

A German captain in Canea raped the 4 year old daughter of Dinioghou.

In Metochi village, Apokoronou area, a young girl aged 10, was raped by a German lieut., 2 women were raped by 10 German soldiers near Alikianes village.

ACTS OF ARSON Kostogherakon, Livada villages and the monastery of Selinou eparchy were bombed on the 29/9/43.

#### A E G E A N I S L A N D S

EXECUTIONS George Kambouris and Dimitri Kambouris were executed in February 1942 in Elata (Chios) for possessing arms. Loukas Bournias was arrested and executed in Chios in April 1942 for possessing arms. Vassilios Kambouris and Const. Kambouris were executed on the 10/5/42 in Chios for attempting to escape to the M.E.

Mathios Protoghircu was executed in Plomariion (Mytilini) in May 1942 for attempting to escape to the M.E.

Efstratios Kopelos from Langada (Chios), seaman, was executed in Lianos in July 1943, for trading explosives.

In our bull. C.40, we mention that 5 persons were executed in September 1943, in "TSALAKIA". One of them is Zlatoglou.

From information received on the 6/12/43, we learn that Germans executed 10 peasants in Samos for cutting telephone wires.

**MURDERS** In March 1942, Petrianos Frangoulis, boat owner, condemned to 15 years imprisonment for helping the escape of many persons to the M.E., died from hardships and starvation in the Chios prisons.

On the 3/5/42, a german soldier was hit by a pebble whilst standing on the quay by the son of Const. Niotou aged 3. The soldier grabbed the child and killed it by hitting its head on the ground. The father who rushed to save his son was seriously wounded.

**ARRESTS** Panayottis Kernas was arrested on the 3/10/41, in Oinoussas (Chios) and detained for 3 months for attempting to escape to the M.E.

In May 1942, Michael Moshouris was arrested and sent to the prisons of Chios for helping Greek officers to escape to the M.E.

The following were sent to Mytilini's prisons in October 1943  
1) Valentia Allighiani, mother of a 4 months old child 2) George Allighiani 3) Irini, sister of Panayotou 4) Kolandris Doukas 5) Efstratios Mamakos 6) Ioannis Makedos 7) Grigorios Maliaros for hiding Panayotis Maidoni, wanted for National activity. During the interrogation all including the women were tortured. It is reported that Greg. Maliaros lost his mind from the tortures to which he was subjected.

On the 26/10/43, Stefanos Ellinas, and Fridas, factory director and 3 other civilians, were arrested in Chios and detained in the prisons for helping escapes to the M.E.

In November 1943, the germans arrested 200 persons from Chios town and surroundings. All were detained in prison for 17 days and then released. Only the following names of these are known to us :-

1) Michael Mihas, Phydian 2) Saakian 3) Isidor Mavridoglou, merchant. From Langada village:- 1) Laskaris Fimaris, seaman 2) Vassilios Poupalos, seaman 3) Stamatios Haralambidis, carpenter 4) Emn. Mathioudis carpenter 5) Leontios Tournis, Captain NEE 6) Dim. Poponis, Captain NEE. Matheos Zimaris, doctor was released together with the above.

The following are amongst the hostages arrested in Mytilini on the 13/11/42 (Bull. C.40 & C.41):

All the above are interned in concentration camps and near Salonica.

**IMPRISONMENTS** In May 1943, the boat owners Ioannis Glikas, Markos Glikas and Dimitrios Kavouras were arrested in Vrontadon (Chios) for helping persons to escape to the M.E. They were court martialled and condemned to 15 years imprisonment.

**ILL-TREATMENTS** In July 1941, Pandolis Koutsouradis was arrested and mercilessly beaten in Paleohorion (Mytilini) because he did not go to work in a factory of his village.

In December 1941, germans fired on 15 year old Antonios Nicolaidis in his boat near Kataraktis, Chios, for attempting to escape to the M.E.

D O D E C A N E S E

EXECUTIONS During November 1943, 5 peasants from Vati, Polakia and Monolithos (Rhodes) villages were executed for entering a prohibited area. Farmer Kavourakis was executed in Alatrika (Rhodes) on the 20/11/43, for possessing a sporting rifle.

MURDERS German soldiers on the 5/10/43, in Psonataria outside Kambos (Ko) stopped Stergion Paraskevas and ordered him to hand over to them all the goods loaded on his mule. As he refused they killed him.

Athanassios was arrested by the Germans on the 7/10/43 in Linotopi village Ko island, on the suspicion that he cut telegraph cables. During the interrogation he was found not guilty and was released. Just after his release, he was shot by the Germans.

On the 15/11/43, a poor woman went to Ko slaughter house to collect remnants of slaughtered animals. A german soldier fired on her but missed her killing the butcher Emm. Lardakis aged 23.

PLUNDERS Immediately after the reoccupation of Ko, the germans systematically looted the island. German soldiers entered houses and shops and carried off everything to their liking, sending their booty by air to Germany.

German soldiers even robbed the civilians in the streets threatening them with their pistols. Leonidas Voukouvalidis, Stelios Thymanakis and Evang. Stavrakis were thus stopped and robbed.

Jews on the Island are constantly persecuted. Manes, the well known merchant was robbed of all his property.

EXILES-DEPORTATIONS From information received on December 1943, we learn that the Generals Manetas, Platis, Ismailos and Vrahnos as well as 100 Greeks mostly officers were sent in September 1943 from Italy where they were interned to concentration camps in Germany.

ITALIAN ATROCITIES

MAIN GREECE

EXECUTIONS The following were sentenced to death by the Italian Martial Courts and executed in Athens :-

- On the 17/4/42 Const. Mavridoglou
- On the 25/9/42 Vassilios Lelos & Periclis Tzigalis
- On the 28/11/42 Antonios Kotsyannopulo
- On the 7/2/43 Antonios Mounkissos
- On the 13/2/43 Const. Kypriadis
- On the 17/6/43, Const. Varghakakis

On the 27/8/43, Panayottis Paoussis, was sentenced to death by the Athens Italian Martial Court for being member of National organisation and executed. During his stay in the Averoff prisons, he was often tortured.

MURDERS Drakopoulos was killed by Italian Carabinieri for participating in a strike in Athens on the 25/3/43 on the anniversary of the National Day of Independence.

ARRESTS Athanassios Platias, merchant was arrested in Periyoli (Fthiotis) in September 1941. He was sent to the Maidarou prisons, Athens, where he was court martialled and sentenced to 5-years imprisonment. After Italy's collapse, he was handed over to the German authorities. The reason of his arrest and condemnation are unknown.

The mother, mother in law and housemaid of Makri, the industrialist were arrested in Athens in October 1941, near Kypseli quarter for hiding a British officer. They were all sent to the Averoff prisons.

The director of Columbia Company was arrested in Athens in December 1941, because the originals of popular songs of the Greco Italian war were found in the archives of his factory.

In September 1943, after the Italian armistice, 800 Greek civilians were still detained in the Averoff prisons by the Italians. From these, the Italians released only 12 on payment of important sums. The remainder were handed over to the German authorities.

ILL-TREATMENTS On the 15/7/41, Italian Carabinieri compelled N. Periclis to wipe out with his tongue patriotic watchwords written on the wall of Athens. A. Panoussopoulos was mercilessly beaten by an Italian 2nd/lieut. in Athens on the 30/11/41, for unknown reasons.

E U V O I A

ARRESTS The Italians on the 4/4/42 arrested the President of Petries (Euvoia) village Community, Andrea Goros and Pan. Tsaliangos for helping Greek officers to escape to the M.E. All were mercilessly beaten and tortured. From these A. Goros was condemned to 6 months imprisonment.

ILL-TREATMENTS On the 17/2/43, the Italians tortured inhabitants of Stira village (Euvoia) suspected of hiding British soldier.

C R E T E

MURDERS Stylianos Matheras and Emma Dakanis were executed by Italian detachments without any trial on the 7/10/42 in Pyrgos village (Maleviziou).

A E G E A N I S L A N D S

MURDERS In July 1941, an Italian soldier Michael Margaritis, farmer, in Mytilini village (Samos) because he was seen in the streets before 8.00 hours.

Ar. Mitsos, Vass. Christodoulou and Ioannis Kaplantis were killed on the 15/2/43 by Italian soldiers in the Mytilini village (Samos) because they protested against the insults of the Italians.

ARRESTS During 1943, a Greek motor vessel was sunk in Aegean sea. Some 65 Greeks escaped and were arrested by the Italians who sent them to Rhodes and later to a concentration camp in Venice (Italy) Amongst them is Apostolos Milas.

ILL-TREATMENTS An Italian 2nd/lieut. kicked and ill-treated the civilian Ilia Vlahos in Karavostamo village (Ikaria) on the 1/3/41, because he did not get out of his way.

In July 1941, Const. Flitsanis was arrested in Four-nous (Samos) and was mercilessly beaten because he did not salute the Italian flag.

The following were arrested on the 21/1/42 in Aghios Kiriko (Ikaria) and beaten mercilessly for helping escapes to the M.E. 1) E. Hrissanthos 2) I. Kontexopoulos 3) A. Kontax poulos.

In April 1943, Lcc. Karaghianis was arrested and tortured in Vathi (Samos) to force him to confess the names of the chiefs of the Guerilla movement in the Island.

BULGARIAN ATROCITIES

CENTRAL MACEDONIA

ARRESTS On the 9/9/43, Bulgarian soldiers and Komitadzis encircled Mesolofos village (Kilkis) and began firing on the innocent inhabitants. They made many arrests and looted the village. A number of inhabitants were wounded.

Since September 1943 in the Pentalofos area, Bulgarian soldiers and Komitadzis commit wide scale atrocities, slaughtering, hanging, arresting, ill-treating the population, violating the women and plundering the villages. In Voulgharaki village, Bulgarian soldiers entered the house of a young man who was a member of a Guerilla organisation and raped his sister. The father tried to resist and so the Bulgarians cut his ears off.

Bulgarian troops on entering Malkidiki (30/9/43) encircled Portes village (Kassandra) in order to search for hidden arms. Many inhabitants were imprisoned in spite of the fact that no arms were found.

On the 5/12/43, 46 inhabitants of Ierisson (Malkidiki) village were arrested by a Bulgarian patrol for infringing the curfew hours. Amongst them are Filipos Mattas and Ioan. Panayottou. They were confined in a house where they were beaten mercilessly. On the next day they were all released except for one who was sent to prison.


