2. GERMAN ARMY AND INTELLIGENCE SERVICE RECENTLY RECONSTITUTED, WITH GENERAL WANTEUFEL CHIEF GENERAL STAFF; GENERAL GUDERJAN, CHIEF ARMORED BRANCH; AIR MARSHAL MILCH, CHIEF OF AIRFORCE. CHIEF INTELLIGENCE FOR WESTERN GERMANY IS MILHEISEN, RESIDENT REGENSBURG, EX-ABWEHR.

3. MILITARY ORGANIZATION DEVELOPING CLAUDESTINELY UNDER BRUDERSCHAFT ORGANIZATION. FORMERLY EVANGELISTISCHE BRUDERSCHAFT.

4. REPORT ALLEGES ENTIRE RECONSTRUCTION OF SERVICE AND ARMY SPONSORED BY AMER. CIA.

5. DEFICIT OBVIOUSLY PLACES GREAT IMPORTANCE ON REPORT. HOWEVER, POINTS OUT MILCH REPORTED IN ARGENTINA. WITH REFERENCE IN IID, REQUEST FULL EVALUATION, AS THIS REPORT CAN HAVE SERIOUS EFFECT ON LIAISON RELATIONSHIPS IF PROPER REASSURANCES NOT FORTHCOMING.
