der Architekten und Ingenieure) he was "Bezirksleiter" in Gumbinnen.

Member of RDB and NSV.

Career outline: Studied engineering in Darmstadt. Passed his examination  
as "Regierungsbaumeister" and was employed by several "Wasserwirtschafts-  
aemter". In 1936 he became acting head of the "Strassenbauverwaltung Saalfeld",  
and was head of the "Strassenbauverwaltung Gera" from Jan 25, 1938 on.  
Later on "Regierungsrat" probably with the "Reichsministerium fuer Ruestung  
und Kriegsproduktion Speer".

Statement of his personal history, executed by him in 1938, and 1942, as  
well as photos showing him in A-SS and W-SS uniform, are on file.
