

FREE POLAND SPECIAL REPORT No 3

The WOLNA POLSKA [Free Poland] Fighting Organization is based-- in accordance with our Political Manifesto--on historical ideals of political independence of the United States Constitution and by virtue of this is conducting an open struggle for Freedom and Independence of Poland. The struggle for the liberation of Poland from the Soviet yoke, conducted jointly with the legal authorities of Independent Poland in Great Britain and other countries, is directed by us primarily against all those in Poland and abroad whose activity is harmful to the interest of Poland and the Polish Nation. We publish the names of such persons systematically in black lists and in "Communicues from the Battlefield," and in the journal "SOHO WEEKLY NEWS" made available to us for this purpose. We receive many letters from true patriots, persons actively engaged in the struggle for independence, and sympathizers of FREE POLAND. It is very gratifying to have so many friends throughout the whole world.

Following disclosure of the names of agents of the Security Service of the MSW and of the Information Service of the PRL Armed Forces in Special Report No 2, a real avalanche of letters poured in to the Administration of FREE POLAND. We have received from various countries, including Poland, much data relating also to CIA and FBI agents acting against the interests of the Republic of Poland, the legal Government of the Republic of Poland in Exile, and Polish organizations. After thorough verification we consider it necessary to publish these data in order to warn all Polish patriots in exile and in Poland against harmful activities that are also being organized by American agents.

In connection with the above, the Chief for Combat Actions of the FREE POLAND Combat Organization publishes the following blacklist of dangerous agents of the CIA and FBI:

W1503

Thomas BLACKSHEAR (b. 1929), Attache, US Embassy, London. Former US Army officer (1952-59). Previously was in Berlin, Frankfurt, New Delhi and Sofia. Directs espionage against the Polish Government in Exile, independence-oriented political parties, and the World Federation of the Polish Ex-Combatants

Association in London. Has in his pay several "influential" CIA agents in Polish organizations with whom he meets in conspiratorial apartments in London, rented in the name of Robert J. Evens, Oxford Street (near Selfridge's) and in Chelsea. We will publish the names of the agents in the next Report. He is being helped in his activities by John F. Pereira, Attache, and Richard M. Luther, Secretary of Embassy, who previously worked at the US Embassy in Warsaw.

W1508

Eugen F. BURGSTALLER, Attache, US Embassy, Paris. Address: Avenue Georges Mandel, telephone 727 52 93. Previously worked in American Embassies in Vienna and Beirut. Conducts espionage against the Polish Ex-Combatants Association in France, the publishing house "Kultura", the editorial office of "Narodowiec," and other Polish organizations in which he maintains a network of informers. One of them is, as we have ascertained, Konstanty A. Jelenski, lavishly paid by CIA in dollars which are regularly transferred to his numbered account in Switzerland. Burgstaller's assistants in the CIA Polish Section in Paris are: Lewis V. Sevier, (b. 1918, works in Consular Department of the Embassy, previously represented the Agency for International Development in Cairo and Beirut), and Nancy M. Campbell (b. 1942) who in 1966-68 was at the US Embassy in Bucharest.

W1512

Michael ANDERSON, Consular Department, US Embassy, Rome (Via Vittorio Veneto 120, telephone 4674). One of his agents is the "liberal Catholic" Stanislaw August Morawski (Roma, Via Giuseppe Melchiori 8/16), founder of the "Centro Studi Europeo," whose activity is funded by the CIA. On orders of Anderson, Morawski spies on Polish bishops arriving in the Vatican, including Cardinal Wyszynski, as well as on Polish organizations in Italy.

W1518

Allen FUERER, Attache, US Embassy, Brussels. Previously worked at US Embassies in Bangkok and Paris. Spies on the Committee of Free Poles and on organizations of the Polish Ex-Combatants Association in Belgium. We will publish the names of his agents in the near future, after a final verification.

W1526

John Edward PALEVICH (b. 21 Aug 1934 in Pennsylvania), at present with the US Embassy in Athens. In 1964-65 was Second Secretary, US Embassy, Warsaw. His agents, among others in

Yugoslavia, watch contacts of Polish independence workers with various centers in Poland. He often visits Belgrade and Rome for meetings with his informers.

W1529

John CZECHEL (Address: First Avenue, New York, N.Y., telephone 784-1234), works in the Library of the Secretariat of the United Nations in New York. He directs on behalf of the FBI an extensive network of agents in Polish organizations in the New York area.

W1536

John DAVIS (b. 25 Jul 1927), Counselor, American Embassy, Warsaw, from 1973. We have verified that he is engaged in intelligence work in the spheres of the Polish Episcopate, clergy, clubs of Catholic intellectuals, and among the Circle "ZNAK." As Chief of the five-member CIA Committee operating at the Embassy he also spies on the contacts and connections of Polish organizations in the United States and other Western Countries with various personalities (especially Catholic) in Poland.

W1539

Yuri KSANDER (b. 1930 in Wilno), Attache, American Embassy, Warsaw. Officer of Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA). Previously visited Poland several times. Engaged in intelligence work primarily among professors of the Polish Academy of Sciences, and the Universities of Warsaw and Kracow.

W1543

Patrick J. NICHOLS, Second Secretary, US Embassy, Poland. Until now a Vice Consul in Kracow. According to data verified by us he spies on Cardinal Woytylo, the higher clergy in Kracow, Katowice, Wroclaw, Lublin and Gdansk, members of the Circle "ZNAK" and other Catholic leaders, as well as connections of the Catholic Church in Poland with Vatican.

W1548

Stefan MICHNIK-SZWEDOWICZ (Uppsala, Flooptawägen 59d, S 752 63). Former Judge of the Supreme Military Tribunal in Warsaw. In the 1950's he sentenced to death many Polish officers, and then was involved in the murder of the journalist, Henryk Holland, who exposed judicial murders of officers and called for the punishment of the guilty. Spies on Polish collaborators of Radio Free Europe and of the publishing house, "Kultura" in

Paris, and especially on their contacts and connections through Sweden with opposition groups in Poland which struggle against the Communist regime.

W1552

Jozef GOLDBLAT (Stockholm, Sveavägen 186, S-113 46). Former regime diplomat in Saigon, Geneva and New York. At present an expert of the International Institute SIPRI in Stockholm where he spies upon Polish organizations and independence leaders, primarily their contacts with scientists, writers and Catholic intellectuals in Poland.

W1564

Jerzy SIDOROWICZ (109 Deloraine Ave., Toronto, Ont., telephone 486-9789). Works in the Ministry of Natural Resources. Before arrival in Canada worked in a military institution in Warsaw and acted as an expert in Zambia. Spies upon activities of Polish independence and minority organizations in Canada and their contacts with higher clergy, Catholic intellectuals and antiregime scientists in Poland.

We call on all Poles who are involved for a mess of pottage in activity against the legal authorities of Independent Poland, to turn back from this path which is harmful to the Polish Nation. We do not absolutely believe in your complete devotion to the principals of the CIA and the FBI. On the contrary, we believe that you are ready to serve the cause of the liberation of Poland. Is not it more sensible to continue to be faithful to the Polish People instead of serving foreigners? We are so organized that we can render you all necessary help. It would be wiser to write to us to seek a way out of the trap. In any letter we request you to quote the file number given in this report.

We thank all collaborators and sympathizers for their help and cooperation. The FREE POLAND Organization calls on all free Poles to be vigilant and to send us further data on anti-Polish agents.
