Request for Use of HARVARD Letter-drop Facilities

1. In our program of contacting returned KUBARK agents and other persons of operational interest among the recent German returnees from the USSR, we would like to make use of HARVARD letter-drop facilities.

2. Since these agents are scattered around West Germany it is considered impractical to employ personal contact to invite them to come to Frankfurt, so that we desire to invite them by letter.

3. As indicated in your discussion with [] and [] the use of HARVARD letter-drop facilities has been approved by [] and COS/Security Branch.

4. The recipients of these letters will, of course, not be given HARVARD telephone numbers, nor will they be invited to visit any HARVARD facilities. If the invitee accepts our invitation, we will make a hotel reservation for him, meet him at the hotel, and escort him to a safehouse where he will be debriefed. We anticipate no other use of HARVARD than the letter-drop.

5. It is planned to initiate letter-writing immediately, and you will, of course, be furnished a list of names to whom letters are being sent. Any responses to these letters should be brought to the attention of [] telephone 7798. These responses will be addressed in care of [] of your office.

6. Attached for your information is a sample copy of the form letter which we propose to use in inviting the agents.
