1. The following is submitted for information purposes.

RIS INPUT NO. 33. On 3 March 1953 Francis Denis POMONIS informant in reference
(a) reported in person the following information:

RIS INPUT NO. 33. That the person named EMKA was now more properly identified as DITTA HAROLD EMBCKE; and that his business address is Via G. da Palestrina 47, Rome.

b. That the person named HASS was now allegedly identified as Carl HASS; and that he was using the last name of GIUSTINI, reported to be the name appearing on his Italian Passport.

c. That both Ugo DEANOSITO and Benito D'Rovera (see reference (a)) were now wearing silver lapel pins or badges, bearing what he (Pomonis) identified as the German Eagle, surrounded by a wreath design. Pomonis stated he had asked about the significance of these lapel pins, and was told they were worn by those who had served in a particular military division under Mussolini in the Northern part of Italy.

3. Pomonis stated that the above information had been gotten from a conversation he had had with Benito D'Rovera (See reference (a)).

4. The CAS representative this area is being made cognizant of the above information.
