1. We would appreciate your initiating name traces on Vilis Arveds HAZNERS in whom we have an operational interest.

2. Subject, a Latvian citizen, born 23 July 1905 in Vircava, Latvia, was formerly a Latvian army officer. He was a member of the board of the Latvian Veterans' organization "Daugavas Vanagi" as well as secretary in both the German and the global bodies of that organization. Since 1953, Subject has been a member of the Committee for a Free Latvia. He came to the U.S. in August 1956.

3. Please have all Information Stations take action. The above referenced dispatches are past traces on the Subject conducted by Pullach, Munich, Frankfurt and Berlin which reflect previous traces made on Subject up to mid-1955 and early 1956. We would therefore appreciate your emphasizing the period from 1956 on in your present traces on Subject.
