SUBJECT : Underground Installation near Kuldiga, Latvian SSR
SOURCE : A Latvian PA (AEKILO/2) residing in USA (B) from
the son (F) of a recent resident (F) of Kuldiga,
Latvian SSR
DOI : September 1961
PLACE ACQUIRED: Stockholm, Sweden (8 November 1961)

1. A usually reliable source, AEKILO/2, reported in October 1961 that the mother of a friend (both of whom reside in the Federal Republic of Germany) revealed the following information:

"There are no Soviet troops stationed in Kuldiga, Latvia. However, a large underground depot, reportedly containing rockets, bombs or atomic bombs, is located approximately five to six kilometers SW of Kuldiga in the direction of Aizpute. Near the underground depot there is a Soviet Army town (Voennyi Gorodok) which is off limits to civilians."

2. SR/2/Comment: The above information tends to confirm and elaborates upon a previous report disseminated in CS 3/409,386. The recent resident of Kuldiga, Latvia, is a 70-year old woman who emigrated from the Latvian SSR to the Federal Republic of Germany in late 1960.
