SUBJECT : Sources of Technical and Scientific Information.

1. Subjects of reference memorandums were consulted as to whether or not they could assist in a project to obtain information relative to biological warfare and scientific progress in the fields of bio-chemistry, bacteriology, physiology and genetics.

2. This family intends to emigrate overseas at the earliest opportunity. However, they do not expect to leave Austria within the next few months and declared themselves willing to assist us in establishing the necessary contacts and channels of communication, and to use the Salzburg letter-box for their correspondence to and from Hungary after their departure from Europe, agreeing that we could open the letters and use any information contained therein. For this work I have offered them 500 schillings per month, payable commencing 1 February 1949, and I also promised to cover travel and other expenses incident to this work.

3. I also told them that our support would be increased later on, providing that contacts are established and production under way.

4. Both of these individuals were extremely reluctant to accept any reimbursement of any kind for their services, although they are desperately short of money.
