<p>SOURCE: Interrogation of Subject</p> <p>1. Subject is 30 years of age and born at LAUTENBACH in Baden where his mother still lives at Hauptstrasse 16. He is a Feldwebel in No. 30 General Kommando, a III F formation commanded by Lt. Col. HEIDSCHUCH.</p> <p>2. He was interrogated on 28 Jan. 45 on the subject of his service in the Abwehr since his section pulled out of Northern France and Belgium at the time of the Allied advance in August. On 23. Aug. he was stationed at TWORP near Brussels. He at that time conceived the idea of returning to LILLE and rejoining the Allies. This proved impossible and he went with his unit to Eindhoven, the to Arnheim, and to Appeldoorn. He arrived at the last place about 10 Sept. The formation was known as I.C. 65 G.K., and was not was not doing real Abwehr work but rather field security duties. The personnel were as follows:</p> <p>O.C. <u>Lt. Colonel HEIDSCHUCH.
